# Give a gift to the AWL that costs nothing today

A legacy gift is the best way for you to help HSV AWL continue our lifesaving work for homeless and abandoned animals. Your gift will be applied to our general operating budget to help ensure Continuance of our mission to rescue and rehome pets within our area served.

- <u>Gifts through your Will or Living Trust</u>: A bequest through a will or trust document is a wonderful way to ensure that your legacy will make a difference <u>for all animals</u> we rescue.
- Gifts through Retirement Assets: Naming AWL as the beneficiary of all or a portion of your retirement plan is a simple and smart way to help our animals. You can create a legacy by naming AWL as beneficiary or contingent beneficiary of an IRA, 401(k), 403(b), Keogh account, or other qualified retirement plan. When a retirement account is left to a charity, the organization does not play the income tax or any applicable estate taxes that might otherwise be due if left to an individual beneficiary. Making a gift simply requires completing a change of beneficiary form, which can be obtained from the plan administrator.
- <u>Gifts through Life Insurance Plans</u>: Identifying Hot Springs Village Animal Welfare League, Inc. as a beneficiary will help us continue our work.
- Outright Gift: An outright gift of cash is an easy and wonderful way to contribute, and you may be entitled to a charitable income tax deduction for the full value of your gift.
- <u>Charitable Gift Annuity</u>: Yet another option for consideration.

From a small group of eight Villagers in 1991, AWL has become a comprehensive rescue organization served by hundreds of dedicated volunteers – No paid employees.

- We have rescued thousands of homeless and abandoned dogs and cats, provided needed vet care, and found loving adopters to give them a forever home.
- We house many rescues in our Adoption Center at the shelter, and give them a temporary safe home. When we have no room at the Adoption Center, we find caring fosters for them.
- Through our cooperative efforts with HSV Property Owners Association, we are committed to No-Kill and have not euthanized a healthy adoptable pet.
- We help low income families in the community spay/neuter their pets to prevent overpopulation of unwanted animals, and help owners find their lost pets.
