

Campout Expectations

Before Leaving

- Pack personal items for the event and show up prepared.
- Double-check your packing list to make sure you have not forgotten anything.
- Arrive on time and ready to help.
- Pack and load troop gear carefully and efficiently.
- Make sure all required personal gear and troop supplies are packed before departure.

Arrival at Camp

- Set up troop gear first before personal setups begin.
- Store and put away all food properly to protect against animals and weather.
- Set up personal gear and tents after troop gear is complete.
- The SPL checks all tents to make sure they are properly set up and secure.
- Keep campsites organized, clean, and safe from the beginning.

During the Campout

- Follow the buddy system and all troop safety rules.
- Respect campsite quiet hours and other campers.
- Keep personal and troop gear organized.
- Clean up after meals and activities.
- Leave shared spaces cleaner than you found them.
- Participate in troop activities and help where needed.

Departure and Cleanup

- Tear down and pack troop gear first.
- Check that troop equipment is clean, dry, and properly stored.
- Pack personal gear after troop gear is completed.
- Conduct a police line to make sure nothing is left behind and to follow Leave No Trace principles.
- Do a final campsite inspection before leaving.

Overall Expectations

- Be helpful, respectful, and prepared.
- Work as a team and contribute to camp duties.
- Take care of troop equipment and the campsite.
- Practice Leave No Trace at all times.
- Represent the troop positively throughout the trip.
