2025 General Election Ballots Certified; Over 140 Candidates Seeking Elected Offices

CANANDAIGUA, N.Y. (09/10/2025) – The Ontario County Board of Elections has certified the ballots to be used in the upcoming November 4, 2025 General Election.

Over 84,000 registered voters in Ontario County are able to cast their ballots by mail or in person in the General Election. Ballots for Early By Mail and Absentee voters (including those with a Permanent Absentee status) will be mailed during the week of September 29th. Voters who wish to cast their ballot in person can do so during the nine-day Early Voting period from October 25th through November 2nd, or from 6:00 AM to 9:00 PM on Election Day November 4th.

Saturday, October 25th is the last day to register to vote in the 2025 General Election and it is also the last date to submit an online or mailed application for an Early Vote By Mail or Absentee ballot. The Board of Elections office at 74 Ontario Street, Canandaigua, will be open that day to receive voter registrations, changes of address, or applications to vote by mail. You may also register to vote, update your voter registration or submit a mail-in ballot application by using the NYS Board of Elections website (<https://elections.ny.gov/>).
