➤ **RESOLUTION #98 – APPROVAL TO APPOINT PART TIME TRANSFER STATION OPERATOR, DANA LYKE**

On motion of Councilman Blazey, seconded by Councilman VanBortel, the following resolution was unanimously ADOPTED:

RESOLVED, to approve the appointment of Dana Lyke, 442 Curran Road, Shortsville, NY 14548, to the position of Part-time Transfer Station Operator, to work on an as needed basis, effective upon adoption this Resolution, at a pay rate of \$13.00/hour, with the potential of a \$0.50 increase after 6-month probationary period.

➤ **RESOLUTION #89 – ACCEPT THE RESIGNATION OF TRANSFER STATION OPERATOR, WILL CIARDI**

On motion of Councilman VanBortel, seconded by Councilman Blazey, the following resolution was unanimously ADOPTED:

RESOLVED, to accept the resignation of Transfer Station Operator, Will Ciardi due to personal reason, effective November 9th, 2020.

BRIEF DISCUSSION was held regarding the Town of Manchester Fees for Solar Farms in comparison with surrounding townships and the potential need to increase or decrease our \$150 fee as the Town Board deems necessary.

BRIEF DISCUSSION was held regarding E-ZPass services for Town of Manchester Residents being available at the Town Clerk's Office. There is an application process to go through with New York State to become a vendor. When approval is granted there is a specific Resolution, we would have to adopt that allows the Town of Manchester to sell the Tags at a cost of \$25.00 per tag, allowing the Town of Manchester to keep \$4.00 of that sale with the remaining \$21.00 going to the NYS Thruway Authority.

➤ **RESOLUTION #90 – APPROVAL TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FOR THE E-ZPASS ON-THE-GO RETAIL SALES PROGRAM APPLICATION**

On motion of Councilman Blazey, seconded by Councilwoman Folkins, the following resolution was unanimously ADOPTED:

RESOLVED, to begin the application process to sell NYS E-ZPass Tags through the Town of Manchester Town Clerk's Office.

BRIEF DISCUSSION regarding the installation of a streetlight at the County Road 13 & Cabbage Patch Lane intersection to reduce the incorrect turns being made by trucks attempting to enter the Cabbage Patch Lane entrance for Leonard's Express. The RGE estimated cost for this streetlight, all-inclusive would be approximately \$13.54723 per month.

➤ **RESOLUTION #91 – APPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION FOR STREETLIGHT INSTALLATION AT COUNTY ROAD 13 AND CABBAGE PATCH LANE**
