

We have the peaceful pleasure

of having a front row seat to the parage of manatees in the canal as well as the opportunity to watch other critters that make themselves at home here. There is Oscar, the Osprey, who enjoys eating the head of his fish catch on the palm frond in front of E building before he takes the rest of the fish back to his wife and family. Sometimes he will even drop down to the ground for his feast. Then there is a Spotted Sandpiper that is a regular visitor in the mornings. It bobs its tail as it moves quickly along the length of our dock on its way back to the Bay. You might also spot the immense Iguana that chooses our dock as a resting place on rare occasions; it must be at least 3 feet long and sports a variety of color variations as well as giant claws on each foot. A Little Blue Heron is a regular visitor: good fishing from our dock must be the draw! Occasionally, we'll be treated to a show by a passing dolphin, either practicing its diving skills or fishing vigorously along the opposite bulkhead. Relax and enjoy the sights!
