- \$\ Discounts/Clubs/Hosts: military
- Facilities: Clean restrooms/showers, camp store, laundry, dumpsters, a pavilion with charcoal grills, and a community fire pit. You could also purchase ice and firewood.
- Amenities: pirate ship playground with a jumbo sandbox, a recreation hall with games such as ping pong, air hockey, and foosball. There is also an outdoor basketball/pickleball court, GaGa pit, sand volleyball, mini golf, tetherball, and corn hole boards. New this year is a craft corner with supplies you can use on their patio or take back to your campsite. Crystal Rock Mining Company Gem Mine on site. There was a separate information sheet that we were given at check-inn that included rental fees for above games/activities.
- Pets & Trails: Not a lot of space for pets as sites were close. No dog park but there was a small field down by the seasonal sites and tent sites that you could use. Our dogs need space to run so this campground was not ideal. No walking/hiking trails.

Sites & Types: tenting w/ or w/o electric, RV water/30 AMP, RV full hook up pull through 30/50 AMP, RV full hook up back in 30/50 AMP, RV full hook up back in 30 AMP, cabin rentals

Check in time is 2PM/Check out time is 11AM

Our Site # A-18 back in full hook up 30/50 AMP. The A -Loop is best for big rigs but it's a tight fit and you are close to your neighbor. A lot of tree coverage so Starlink was not happy. There was also some kind of motor running 24/7 down below sites A-16, A-17 that we could hear in the background. Sites had fire pits and picnic tables; outdoor rugs were not allowed.
