We paid \$69 per night but stayed 6 nights & got the 7<sup>th</sup> night free. Total of \$414 for the week



Discounts/Clubs/Hosts: stay 6 nights get the 7<sup>th</sup> night free or Good Sam, Passport America (PA accepted before Memorial Day & after Labor Day, Sunday through Thursday)



Facilities: Office, camp store, snack shack, EV charging station, Shower, bath house, dumpster, can recycling. You can purchase LP gas, firewood, & ice. No laundry on site. Gated entrance with key code/key entrance only after 8:30 PM. Campground Staff guide you into your site.



Amenities: Horseshoes, playground, catch & release fishing, dock, paddleboat rentals, volleyball, basketball, bocce, shuffleboard, & a 9 tee frisbee golf course. There is also a swimming pool, rec hall, & game room.




Pets & Trails: There is a pond surrounded by grass that you can walk around, a nice sized fenced dog park for off leash, on leash walking throughout the campground but not allowed in buildings or on the playground

Check in time is 2:00 PM/Check out time is 1:00 PM
