- Facilities: check-in & office, laundry, restrooms & showers, Event Center: Rec Hall, Kitchen, & buffet area, storm shelter, trash bins, cardboard, plastic & aluminum can recycle bins
- Amenities: Heated indoor swimming pool, Exercise room, Game room, catch & release fishing pond with lit walking paths playground, Lizzie Mae's Mercantile Trading Post & Christmas Shop, pickleball, basketball
- Pets & Trails: Very large, fenced dog park with two separate sections (one smaller one with pebbles and one larger one with grass (or mud & puddles in our case). Some boards were broken or missing, wire fencing not secure in all areas, and it felt like a small dog could squeeze through the fencing gaps in some areas. Dog station bags & disposal areas available. There are no other grassy areas for pets throughout the park. Pets are not allowed on the playground or on the paths that wander around the catch & release fishing pond.

- Sites & Types: 34 back in sites and 177 pull through sites all with full hook-ups plus cable, many big rig friendly sites that are very long although not very wide. Pull through sites separated by wooden fences, gravel & dirt base, concrete slab for picnic table, no fire pits.
- Check in time in time is 12 noon/Check out time is 12 noon
- Our Site #127 It was very long not as wide as we prefer, gravel with dirt areas mostly level. Our site did not fill with as much water as some of the sites. We were glad we had rubber boots.
- Our Stay: Original plan was 11/4-11/8 but due to severe weather in Oklahoma we came earlier and stayed Friday November 1<sup>st</sup>- Friday November 8th
- Cell/Internet/WiFi/Starlink/etc: free WiFi available, we used StarLink
- Would we revisit? No although the price was right. You are surrounded by very busy roads. You can hear & see the traffic on I-40 24/7.
