Facilities: Camp store, laundry, bagged trash pick-up from your site (8AM-6:30PM), firewood \$10 for 7 pieces of wood, propane was \$4.72 Gallon, dump station, storage



Amenities: outdoor pool (open Memorial Day-Labor Day), bike rentals, bocce ball, jumping pad, giant-sized chess & checkers, horseshoes, basketball, playground, gravity rail zipline, pavillion, community fire pit, seasonal planned activities, outdoor movie cinema, corn hole, volleyball, ladderball, GaGa Ball, arts & crafts



Pets & Trails: Camp K9 fenced in area for off leash, nature trails (we did not explore)



Sites & Types: Big Rig friendly with some 90 foot pull-throughs, pull through, back-ins, 50, 30 AMP, full hook-ups, water/electric, tenting, cabins, some sites with patios



Check in time is 1:00PM/Check out time is 11:00AM

It was big rig friendly, and our neighbors were big rigs that made us feel sandwiched in without a view except for the side of their RV.
