Pets & Trails: Pets must be always leashed when outside your RV and/or walking the campground. There is an open grassy area for pets and a path around the pond.

Sites & Types: 35 full hook-up sites with 50/30/20 AMP, most pull through, some back-in, big rig friendly, 7 are laser leveled concrete pads, and the rest are mostly level gravel sites.
