Discounts/Clubs/Hosts: Good Sam, Military/Veteran, Senior applied only for stays less than 7 nights. Daily/weekly/monthly/long-term rental rates available.



Facilities: laundry, bathroom/showers, storm shelters, propane, morning trash pick-up, banquet hall (can be booked for special events or RV rallies), koi ponds, gift shop and office, they do accept package deliveries,



Amenities: playground, rec room, TV lounge, dominoes, pool table, PacMan & other games, shuffleboard, basketball,



Pets & Trails: 2 dog runs, indoor dog wash station



Sites & Types: 20/30/50 AMP, pull-through, back-in, big rig friendly, 16' wide concrete sites, 102 sites, fire pits, picnic tables, and some sites have a rock garden waterfall





Check in time is 1:00PM/Check out time is 11:00AM




Our Site # 68 very nice corner site, easy pull through, full hook-ups (the high winds kept blowing over our sewer hose until we steaked down the plastic black sewer hose support), nice firepit, long picnic table but worn, concrete slab was long

& wide. We were allowed to wash our RV, which was nice. The only restriction was that we used Dawn dish soap.

 Our Stay: Monday October 28-Monday November 4, 2024 (we left Friday November 1st due to severe weather)

 Would we revisit? Maybe. The RV Park was very well maintained and clean. The price was very affordable. The sites were concrete slabs, mostly level, long & wide, and very big rig friendly. It was quiet. Some of the long-term residents' rigs were older and worn out (not an eye-sore like a campground in Maine we stayed at but still stuck out). The weather would always be a concern to us since this stay, we chose to leave early due to damaging winds, flooding rain, tornadoes, and hail. I see why there were many underground storm shelters spaced throughout the campground. They are conveniently located ¼ mile off I40 exit #84.
