CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The event is run under Pony Club rules. Riders' dress and horses' saddlery must conform with rules for cross country section of Pony Club Eventing Rules 2012 except that numnahs or saddle cloths of any colour may be worn.
- Competitors must wear a protective helmet with cover at all times when mounted manufactured to one of the following standards:-BS Kitemark and CE and either PAS015:1998 or 2010, BS EN 1384:1997, EN 1384:1996.
 OR Australian certified and CE and either AS/NZS 3838 1998 or 2003.

OR Snell E2001 with CE and the official Snell number.

A jockey skull cap with no fixed peak must be worn when riding cross country over fences 80cm and above. It is also strongly recommended over lower fences. Hats must be fitted with a pony club tag and/or be subject to checks on the day.

- 3. A medical armband must be worn for cross country (available on the day). An effective body protector must be worn for cross country.
- 4. Age of competitor as at 1st January 2012. Horses must be at least 5 years old.
- 5. A horse/pony may compete only once per class, except in the case of a 13yrs or over rider in Class 1.
- 6. No horse/pony may go round more than three times overall except where accompanying a child. (as 5 above.)
- 7. The judge's decision is final.
- 8. Competitors in Levels 2, 3 and 4 will be asked to LEAVE THE COURSE after elimination due to the third refusal, run out or circle at the same fence. To help the competitors complete the course there are many 'L' ALTERNATIVES.
- 9. Excessive use of spurs, whip, etc and use of offensive language by competitors or supporters will be heavily penalised.
- 10. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or change any class or awards.

LEGAL LIABILITY Neither the organisers nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for loss, damage or injury to horses, ponies, competitors or any person or property whatsoever.

HEALTH & SAFETY The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.
