

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 The event will be run under The Pony Club Eventing Rules 2015 which can be downloaded from The Pony Club website www.pcuk.org Riders' dress and horses saddlery must conform with rules.
- 2 Competitors must wear a protective helmet with cover at all times when mounted manufactured to one of the following standards:-
British — PAS 015:1998 or 2011/ BS EN1384: 1996, 1997 or 2012
European — EN1384:1996, 1997 or 2012
All the above with the BSI kitemark

A jockey skull cap with no fixed peak must be worn when riding cross country over fences 0.8m and above. It is also strongly recommended over lower fences.

Hats must be fitted with a Pony Club tag and/or, be subject to checks on the day.
- 3 **Medical armbands** must be worn for the cross-country & will be on sale at the event.
An effective body protector must be worn for cross country even if an air jacket is being worn.
- 4 Ages of competitors as on 1 January 2015
- 5 Horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old and may not compete more than once. Riders will be restricted to two horses per class initially. Further entries will depend on available spaces at closing date.
- 6 Combination of horse and rider which has been competing at a higher level course than that entered can only be accepted as a Hors Concours entry provided space is available.
- 7 Competitors will be asked to **leave the course** after elimination due to the third refusal, run out or circle at the same fence. To help competitors complete the course there are many '**L**' alternatives.
- 8 Excessive use of spurs, whip etc and the use of offensive language by competitors or supporters will be heavily penalised.
- 9 The wearing of stop watches on the cross country course is not allowed.
- 10 The organisers reserve the right to cancel or change any class or awards.
