CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Horse/pony may compete only once in each individual class but in pairs they may compete more than once with different partners.
- 2. Horses/ponies must be at least 4 years old.
- 3. Competitors must wear a protective helmet with cover at all times when mounted, manufactured to one of the following standards:
 - BSI Kitemark and CE and PAS015:1998, 2003 or VG1
 - Australian certified and CE and AS/NZS 3838 1998, 2003 or 2006
 - Snell E2001 with CE and official Snell number
 - ASTM F1163 2004a with SE1 mark

A jockey skull-cap must be worn for cross-country riding over fences 80cm or higher and is also strongly recommended for cross-country riding over lower fences. Hats must be fitted with a white Pony Club tag or red British Eventing tag and will be checked.

- 4. An effective body protector must be worn. For Classes 5, 6 and 7 the body protector must meet BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label).
- 5. In the case of over-subscription, entries received first will have priority.
- 6. The organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes.
- 7. Awards may be varied according to entries.
- 8. Entry money will be refunded for withdrawals before the closing date.
- 9. The judges' decision is final. Objections in writing with £10 deposit will be accepted according to Pony Club rules.

LEGAL LIABILITY
