CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The event is run under Pony Club rules. Rider's dress and horse's saddlery must conform with the cross- country section of PC Eventing Rules 2018 <u>www.pcuk.org</u>
- 2. Horse/pony may compete only once in each individual class but in pairs they may compete more than once with different partners. No horse/pony may go round more than three times overall.
- 3. Horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old.
- 4. Competitors must wear a protective helmet with cover at all times when mounted, manufactured to one of the following standards:
 - *PAS015:1998 or 2011 with BSI Kitemark
 - VG1 with BSI Kitemark
 - *Snell E2001* with the official Snell label and number
 - ASTM-F1163 2004a with the SEI mark
 - AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards
 - * These hats meet higher impact criteria and therefor give more protection.

A jockey skull-cap must be worn for cross-country riding over fences 80cm or higher and is also strongly recommended for cross-country riding over lower fences.

Hats must be fitted with a PC, BE, or BRC aquamarine tag and will be checked.

- 5. An effective body protector meeting BETA2009 Leve I3 standard (purple label) must be worn.
- 6. Competitors in classes 6 to 13 will be asked to LEAVE THE COURSE after elimination due to the third refusal, run out, or circle at the same fence. To help competitors complete the course there are many 'L' alternatives.
- 7. Excessive use of spurs, whip, etc. and use of offensive language by competitors or supporters will be heavily penalised.
- 8. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or change any class or award.
- 9. Entry money will be refunded for withdrawals before the closing date.
- The judge's decision is final. Objections in writing with £10 deposit will be accepted according to Pony Club rules.

LEGAL LIABILITY
