

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1 The event will be run under The Pony Club Dressage Rules 2020 and rules for The Pony Club Spring Festival Dressage Series 2021/22. (See www.pcuk.org)

2 Horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old.

3 Competitors must wear a protective helmet with cover at all times when mounted, manufactured to one of the following standards:

- PAS 015:1998 or 2011 with BSI Kitemark
- VG1 with BSI Kitemark
- Snell E2001 with official Snell label and number
- ASTM-F1163 2004a with SEI mark
- AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards

Hats must be tagged.

Smart turnout is required but horses'/ponies' manes need not be plaited.

4 Excessive uses of spurs, whip etc and use of offensive language by competitors or supporters will be penalised.

5 The organisers reserve the right to cancel or change any class or award.

**PONY CLUB SPRING FESTIVAL PRELIMINARY ROUND
Preliminary Rounds qualifying for the Area Competition**

Open to members of any Pony Club Branch or Pony Club Centre and to non-members up to the year in which they become 25 years old. Please note that any non-member who qualifies in a preliminary round must become a fully paid-up Pony Club member before competing in the Area Competition. In the event of a competitor who has already qualified for the Area Competition being placed in a qualifying position at this fixture, the place may be passed down the line.

Please note the following restrictions:

NOVICE LEVEL The following are NOT eligible:

Riders who have represented their branch/centre at Open Area Dressage or above (this includes summer and/or winter Area Competitions).

At Preliminary Rounds riders are not eligible if they have won BD (or DI) points at Novice level or above. If they have competed at more than two Novice My Quest/team Quest competitions. Or if they have competed at BD Novice Music competitions.

INTERMEDIATE LEVEL The following are not eligible:

Combination of horse/pony and rider are NOT eligible if they have represented a Branch/Centre at Open Area Dressage or above (this includes summer and/or winter Area Competitions).

A League Table will be run over the course of the Burton Hunt Evening Dressage events, these will be held on 03/12/2021, 07/01/2022, 04/02/2022 and 04/03/2022.

Points will be awarded on class placings as follows: 1st = 7pts, 2nd = 6pts, 3rd = 5pts, 4th = 4pts, 5th = 3pts, 6th = 2pts. Non placed = 1pt

The levels will be split LR/assisted, Intro/Walk/Trot test. PC Grassroots/PC Novice/Prelim tests. BD Novice/PC Intermediate tests.

Combinations must attend 2 league events to qualify
