

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The event is run under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2020. Which can be downloaded from www.pcuk.org
2. If horse/pony competing in XC then they may compete only once in each individual class but in pairs they may compete more than once with different partners. No horse/pony may go round XC more than twice overall.
3. If horse/pony competing solely in dressage & showjumping then horse/pony can compete in more than one class with different riders up to a total of not more than 4 classes
Horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old. Riders' ages as on 01.01.2021
4. Competitors must wear a protective helmet with cover at all times when mounted, manufactured to one of the following standards:
 - *PAS015:1998 or 2011 with BSI Kitemark
 - VG1 with BSI Kitemark
 - *Snell E2001* with the official Snell label and number
 - ASTM-F1163 2004a with the SEI mark
 - AS/NZS 3838, 2003 or 2006 onwards

* These hats meet higher impact criteria and therefore give more protection.
A jockey skull-cap must be worn for cross-country riding over fences 80cm or higher and is also strongly recommended for cross-country riding over lower fences.
Hats must be fitted with a PC, BE, or BRC aquamarine tag and will be checked.
Attire as per pony club competition rules. Horse/pony – do not need to be plaited.
5. An effective body protector meeting BETA2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) or BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue & black label) must be worn.
6. Competitors in all classes will be asked to LEAVE THE COURSE if considered dangerous or impacting on other riders.
7. Excessive use of spurs, whip, etc. and use of offensive language by competitors or supporters will be heavily penalised.
8. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or change any class or award.
9. Entry money will be refunded for withdrawals before the closing date.
10. In the Event of Cancellation, booking fees will be retained,.

LEGAL LIABILITY

Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

30 mins after your test. All tests can be read

CROSS-COUNTRY RULES (Please note this is not cross-country schooling.)

- 1 You will have a start time and must start only when stewards allow.
- 2 The course must be ridden in fence number or letter order.
- 3 After 3 refusals at one fence, you must move on.
- 4 If you are deemed unsafe or riding dangerously you will be asked to leave the course and walk back to the lorry park.
- 5 The mini 45cm Cross-Country course will be shorter and separate from the main course, will include some knockdown fences and has no water complex.

Covid-19 Guidelines will be followed.

ARRIVE – COMPETE – LEAVE

Competitors must display a copy of their rider number(s) in the windscreen of their car/lorry.
