Rules

1. Participation in the club facilities is for club members and their guests only. A family membership consists of the member, a spouse or significant other and any dependent children under 18 years of age.
2. A member must accompany guests using club facilities. A guest may visit the facility once before they must join the club
3. Non-members may participate in function open to the public
4. No person under the age of 16 will be permitted on the range, unless accompanied by an adult member who will assume responsibility for their conduct and safety
5. Members must always maintain their membership card while on club grounds and must be shown to any member upon request
6. No guns of any type may be taken on or used on the archery range
7. Persons using the facilities will drive at a safe speed not exceeding 15 mph and only on established roads. No unauthorized vehicles are permitted on the range.
8. Range closure markings or signs will be honored when displayed, such as range closed for maintenance, set up for a shoot, or closed for fire warning.
9. No persons may enter the range if they have consumed alcohol on that calendar date. Under no circumstances is alcohol of any kind allowed on the range.
10. Unauthorized fires are prohibited. Fire danger signs will be heeded when posted. Fireworks are prohibited. Smoking is only allowed in the clubhouse permitted areas. Fire danger rating goes along with the county and state recommendations. No burning allowed
11. No unauthorized cutting of trees or shrubs
12. Littering on the club grounds is prohibited
13. Any violation of club rules may call for disciplinary action by the board of directors and may include: A) a warning B) loss of privilege to use range C) revocation of membership D) if violation warrants, information will be turned over to the county attorney or other authority for prosecution
14. No broadheads allowed unless broadhead targets are in use.
