1) The following fees for the Honoring Our Nations Veterans Pow Wow 2022 including a Vendor Donation Item are:

Arts/Crafts: 10x10 (\$250) 10x20 (\$300) 20x20 (\$500)

Food: 10x10 (\$250) 10x20 (\$300) 20x20 (\$500)

Drinks/Snacks: 10x10 (\$250) 10x20 (\$300)

Vendors will be charged \$50 for every additional 10 feet needed

2) All booth space will be assigned in the order the application is received.

3) Setup can begin after completed application and full payment submitted. Setup date is Friday, Dec 2th, 2022

4) One (1) paid space per vendor, unless additional space is approved and paid in advance. No motor homes, canopies, tents, etc. are allowed for personal camping purposes in the vendor area. You must setup your tent in the camping area.

5) You may not drive your vehicle in the area to load or un-load. No vehicles are allowed to drive in grass areas unless guided by an OFFICIAL. Vehicles cannot be left unattended. NO EXCEPTIONS.

6) Electrical hookup(s) and water will be available. You must provide your own electrical cords and hoses.

7) Craft vendors are limited to 1 electrical outlet per booth. Food vendors are limited to 3 electrical outlets per booth.
Additional outlets needed by vendors will be charged \$25 an outlet.

8) You must take your own trash to the dumpsters. **Do not use the trash cans.** The trash cans are for our guests and should not be used as a dumpster. Vendors must clean up their area or will be fined a fee for trash removal.

9) YOU MUST PROVIDE A COPY OF YOUR FOOD HANDLERS' PERMIT AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION. You must openly display your vendor permit, food handlers' permit, and extinguisher in your stand.

10) Art/Crafts must be authentic Native American products unless given permission prior by an OFFICIAL. We will not allow vendors to sell reproductions or imported "Native American" products.

11) **No Arts/Crafts vendors are allowed to sell food in their stations. If an Arts/Crafts vendor is selling food at their station they will be fined with an additional \$300.**

12) NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POWWOW GROUNDS OR VENDOR AREAS! NO EXCEPTIONS

13) Inappropriate toys such as projectile toys (sling shots, guns, catapults, or marshmallow guns), real-like weapons, and tobacco products (such as cigars and cigarettes) WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES.

14) All complaints must be in writing and directed to the Honoring Our Nations Veterans Pow Wow Committee.

15) **ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS due to Inclement Weather a Credit will be given towards the next Pow Wow Event.**

16) Absolutely no alcohol, drugs, firearms, weapons, or fireworks are allowed on the premises or stored in the vendors' vehicle. NO EXCEPTIONS.

17) Security will be in service, but PLEASE take all money and valuables with you at night. Honoring Our Veterans Pow Wow WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE THEFT OF OR DAMAGE TO YOUR PROPERTY.
