Dr. Milton Wallack, D.D.S. – Retired Board Member

Dr. Milton Wallack, a retired periodontist, has been a faculty member at Boston University School of Dental Medicine, the University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine and the Yale Dental Residency Program. He is the founder of the Connecticut Stem Cell Research Coalition and was involved in establishing the Connecticut Life Science Group. He was a founder of StemCONN and the International Association of Stem Cell Research, as well as the dental hygiene program at the University of New Haven.

Dr. Wallack has served as president of the New Haven Chapter of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation, and president of the Jewish Federation of Greater New Haven, where he reestablished the organization's Community Relations Council. He has also served on the board of governors of the University of New Haven and on the board of trustees of Brandeis University, where he chaired the board of fellows. He also serves as a founding member of the Metabolic Research Alliance, a research consortium involving Yale University, the University of Connecticut, Jackson Laboratory and the Weizmann Institute of Science in Israel.
