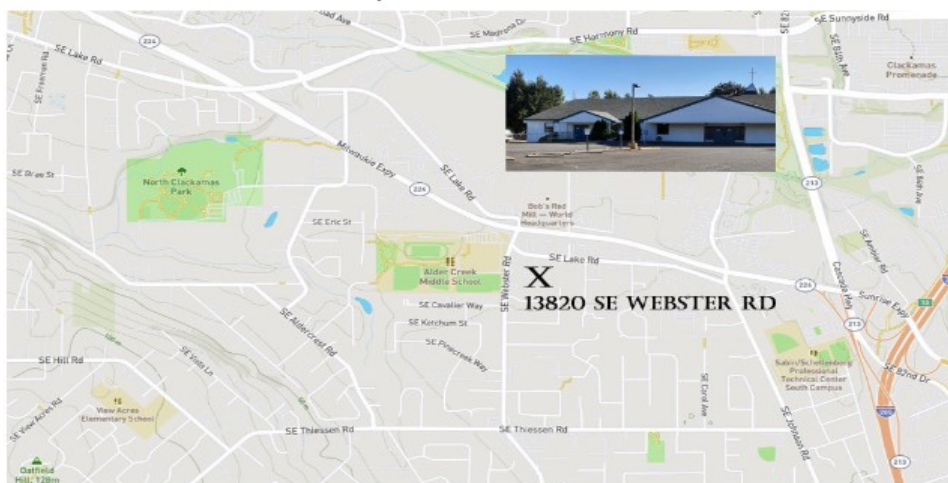

Regular meetings are held at the Saving Grace Church from 11am to 2pm, on the 2nd Tuesday of each month. **Next meeting February 11 , 2025**



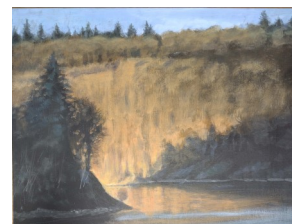

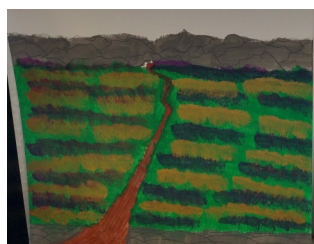

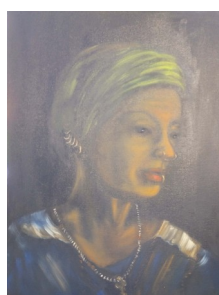
