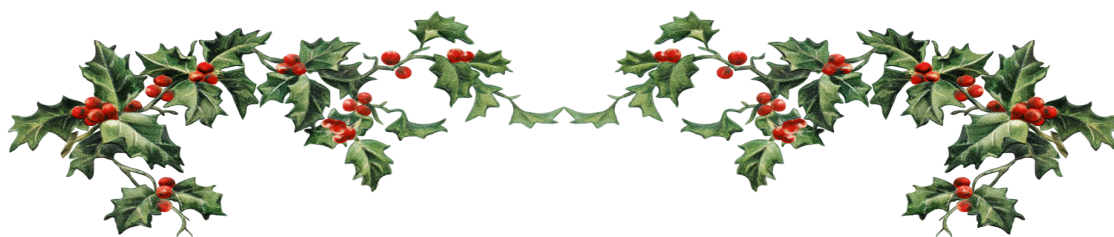
Attending our meetings is a great way to meet fellow artists. Art demos are given by some of the best Portland area artists and make for a great learning experience.

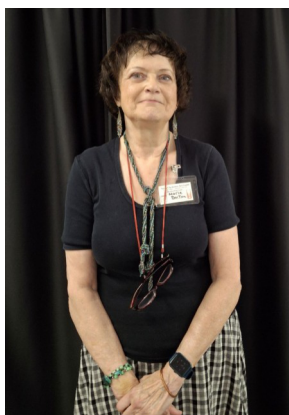

If there is still time, take a trip to Clackamas Town Center to see our guild outshine every other usual Christmas decoration in the mall.

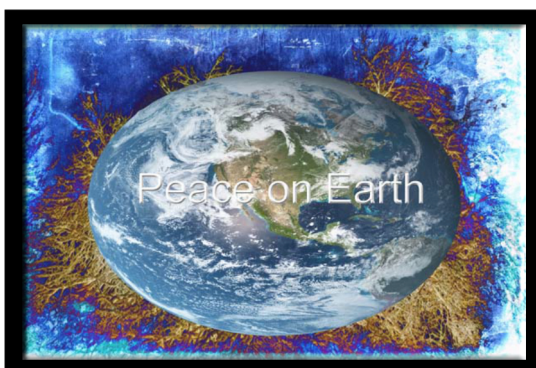
Congratulations to Anne and all the artists who lent their paintings for this sparkling, bright, heartfelt display. The range of talent, color, theme...it's all remarkable!

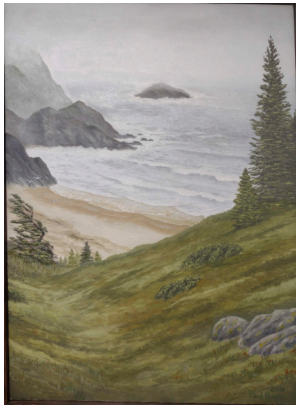
