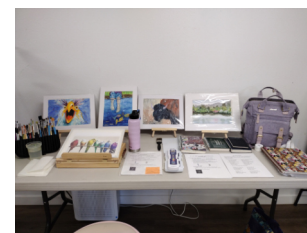
Plein air on the Willamette River Gary Michael



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Plein air classes were held July 29 and August 19. Char Tritt, Beckie Friswald, and Paul Boggs enjoy painting with advice from Gary Michael.

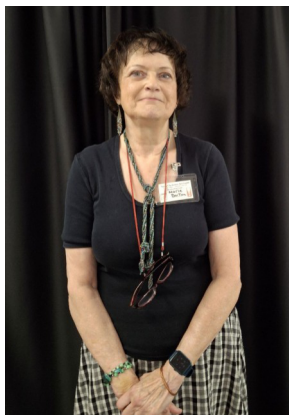
August Demo Guest Artist: Barbara Seliner



Welcome All

Attending our meetings is a great way to meet fellow artists. Art demos are given by some of the best Portland area artists and make for a great learning experience.

Barbara Seliner presented an informative demonstration on how to get started with watercolor painting. She has been painting with watercolors for several years and shared with us the types of brushes she uses and mentioned one doesn't need to spend a lot of money on brushes. She showed us what to look for in the brush construction as well as the types of hair used in the making of the brushes. She also discussed types of paints. She recommended starting with a pallet of pan paints that are inexpensive, but as the paint is depleted, buying better quality tube paints and squeezing that into the pans. She demonstrated the various types of techniques for watercolor such as wet-on-wet, wet-on-damp, wet-on-dry, and dry brushing. She had handouts with information on her preferred art resources in the Clackamas County area and highly recommended "I Been Framed Art Supply," as well as a couple of others.
