THE FACTS

Who should apply: If you answer yes to two or more of the following, you should consider applying:

- -I am 21-26 years old.
- -I know Jesus in my mind but not my heart.
- -My faith feels stale.
- -I feel spiritually and/or emotionally unequipped.
- -Thinking about the future brings anxiety.
- -I desire to get uncomfortable.
- -I believe more lies about myself than truth.
- -My community is not sharpening me.
- -I don't understand what I am created for.
- -I feel behind.

Cost: \$8,000. \$500 due upon acceptance.

Lodging: We connect each Fellow with a host family for the duration of the program.

Employment: We balance each Fellow's desire and expertise with the needs of our partners in our network. We work together to find part-time employment. Expect to work 24-30 hours per week Monday-Wednesday.

Curriculum: Expect to read, write, listen, and discourse every week. Each week involves a deeper understanding and practice of Jesus' call to discipleship.
