 - You are responsible for your assigned date. You can switch with someone (within your SGL group/room) - you have the roster to contact another leader. *Please do not ask me to do this for you.*
 - **IMPORTANT**— If you switch with someone, **please let me know.**
 - All leaders will lead the meeting once or twice this year – a schedule for January-April will come out later.
 - Nan will remind you by email the week that you are assigned.
 - Some weeks will have a Ministry Grid – these will be 4 of our 6 Expanded Lessons.
 - When there is a **LIVE** training, all SGL's meet at 8:10 in room 152 - afterwards you go to your assigned room for the lesson discussion.
 - You are responsible for the whole 70 minutes of our leaders' meetings (8:10-9:20).
 - Please begin and end on time.
 - **DO NOT SKIP YOUR GROUP PRAYER TIME TOGETHER – plan for 10-15 min.**

Here is the breakdown of the leaders' meeting....

1. prayer: 10-15+ min.

- at the beginning or end of the meeting - your decision. **If ending w/prayer you must finish your lesson discussion no later than 8:10.**
- prayer time together as a large group or divide us up into pairs/small groups - your decision.

#### Leadership Helps:

Ask yourself some questions to help you prioritize what question(s) to use:

- \*Which questions promote discussion, and which are simple factual questions?
- \*Are there any questions I can combine?
- \*Is there a question or two I can summarize and then ask a follow-up question?
- \*Pick a question to do the 'pair & share' strategy.
- \*Admit when you need outside resources for insight. Chances are others struggled too. So, go ahead and ask for a "Resource Reflect" and set it up like this- "What additional insights did you get from the QR code article?"
- \*Prioritize time for application questions – we want life change/spiritual transformation.
