2. What person from the Bible would you most like to meet and why?
3. If you could insert yourself into any story of the Bible, what would you choose?
4. What is one book of the Bible you would like to learn more about?
5. Which person from the Bible do you most admire and why (other than God/Jesus)?
6. What is your favorite book of the Bible and why?

PICK ONE TO SHARE:

1. If you could have coffee with any woman in the Bible, who would it be?
2. What was the first Bible verse you learned by heart?
3. If you could ask God one question and get an answer now, what would it be?
4. Who's one person who helped you grow in your faith?
5. What does resting on the Sabbath look like for you?
6. Which fruit of the spirit is easiest for you? Which one is the toughest?
