Summer Boardwalk Art Exhibition - Port of Brookings Harbor



You may acquire a blank art panel at the [Manley Art Center, 433 Oak St., Brookings, OR](#) beginning on **March 10**. Only art on these panels will be accepted for the exhibit. Your nonrefundable **\$10 entry fee** includes one art panel. A limited number of panels will be available, and only one panel/one entry per artist.

The blank art panels are 16' x24" and ready to paint. You may paint directly on the art panel or affix a "front" surface on the supplied art panel and seal it. Acrylic paint is suggested but any medium may be used as long as it is sealed well.

The artwork must be your own, original artwork. Art previously submitted to ART at the PORT will not be accepted. Prints of any media other than digital artwork or photographs will not be accepted. All components of digitally created art must be your own work or your own photographs and not copied and pasted from another source.

Items attached to the front of the panel may be up to 1" deep. Use glue that is not water soluble. Epoxy or E600 is suggested. No attachments to the sides of the panel.

Artwork may be presented in "landscape" (horizontal) or "portrait" (vertical) orientation.

All surfaces must be sealed because of the exposure to the sun, rain, fog, wind and temperature swings.

Your artwork should follow the theme of "**Paradise by the Sea**" (Coastal and marine images, real or imagined)

Clearly print your name on the back and top of the panel with a permanent ink marker or acrylic paint.

Deliver completed art panels on **May 17 or 18 between 10 AM and 1 PM** to [Pithitude Gift Shop](#).

Artworks must be family-friendly and non-political. Entry will be declined if the artwork does not follow the guidelines.

Artworks will be publicly exhibited from **May 18 until September 13** at the [Port of Brookings Harbor Boardwalk](#).

People's Choice Ballots will be available on the boardwalk from **May 18 through September 4**. Awards will be announced during **Labor Day Weekend**. The exhibit will remain in place until **September 13**.

Arrange for your artwork to be picked up between **10 AM and 1 PM on September 13** at the [Boardwalk](#). Unclaimed panels will be stored for 30 days and then recycled.

Winning artwork will be transported to the [Manley Art Center](#) and displayed during the month of October. Artwork must be picked up at the [Manley Art Center](#) on **November 1 and 2 from 10 AM until Noon**.

You may sell your artwork, however, artwork must remain at the [Boardwalk](#) until **September 13, or November 1** if your artwork wins. Prices may not be posted on the Boardwalk. Prospective buyers contact Manley Art Center. Buyers' contact information will be provided to the artists. All sales are by private transaction between the artist and the buyer. October sales made at Manley Art Center are subject to the gallery's commission.

By signing the entry form, you grant permission for the Port of Brookings Harbor and Manley Art Center to share images and general editorial detail about your artwork, for noncommercial, not-for-profit purposes.

By signing the entry form, I understand that the exhibit is outdoors and open to the public. I release and hold harmless the Port of Brookings Harbor and Pelican Bay Arts Association from liability for loss or damage due to weather, theft, vandalism, or other causes.
