## Cyndee Stegall *Glass Enamel*

I am a glass artist, living and working on the magnificent Southern Oregon Coast. My medium is many forms of glass, rendered in kiln-formed applications. I mainly do glass enamel paintings, glass lighting, sculpted glass pieces and molded glass items, as well as glass jewelry and commission pieces.

Glass captivates me in all it's forms, and when I discovered kiln-formed glass, I became interested in ways to translate other art forms, such as traditional oil painting, into fused glass. This started me on a mainly self-taught journey, working to learn the scientific limitations of glass while interpreting the medium into traditionally recognized art forms.

Fused glass is an endlessly fascinating subject for me, despite its many challenges. Being able to spend my days contemplating and creating beautiful things is a gift, and I am very grateful for this chapter.

## Is the Manley Art Center Named for Virginia Manley or Clive Manley?

Since Virginia Manley's portrait hangs at Manley Art Center and Virginia Manley was the donor of the property and building used by PBAA, is it a common initial assumption that Manley Art Center is named for her. According to various letters including a letter to PBAA from Connie McIntyre, "The Manley Art Center was so named in honor of Virginia's deceased husband, Clive Manley" and PBAA historians have repeated this "fact" many times and even included it in brochures.



Now to confound history: In notes scribbled for the PBAA Directors Meeting on Nov 27, 1981 on the back of a General Telephone envelope postmarked October 7, '81, Virginia Manley wrote: " I had thought it might be appropriate to include the name Clive Manley in the name of the center. But someone said why not my name as I was the donor. You know I am just enough of a ham to think that would be wonderful."

Manley Art Center honors both Clive and Virginia Manley who contributed so much to the creation, development and support of Pelican Bay Arts Association, but it was Virginia's dream and persistence over considerable negativity that made an Art Center out of a once ramshackle little house.
