The Language of Trees

Pam's art moves beyond realism, offering a vivid and powerful interpretation of the natural world that deepens the viewer's connection to it. Her distinctive style is colorful, highly textured, and semi-abstract, yet always grounded in recognizable natural forms. She works primarily in watermedia, including both acrylics and watercolor.

Dividing her time between Ashland and Bandon, Oregon, Pam came to painting after a career as a social science professor at Stanford University and the University of Texas at Austin. Returning to her first love of art, she studied at the Oregon College of Arts and Crafts and Scottsdale Art School, and pursued private mentorships with three nationally recognized watermedia artists.

Pam has served as artist-in-residence at three National Parks—Lassen (CA), Glacier (MT), and Lake Clark (AK). She is a signature member of Artists for Conservation and the International Society of Experimental Artists, and her work has been featured in both public and private commissions. Notable projects include the 2019 Britt Festival playbill cover and a 7 x 14-foot native plant mural for Southern Oregon University.

Her award-winning art has been featured on television and radio, and her paintings have appeared in literary journals and as book covers. She is represented by Art & Soul Gallery in Ashland, OR, and Second Street Gallery in Bandon, OR.
