winter of sanding. Cleaned up two cemeteries the week before Mothers Day. At Christmas they decorated a tree inside and outside the church. On July 1st. Beaumont Hamel and November 11TH. Remembrance Day celebrations they laid a wreath. St. Ignatius entered a float into the Santa Clause parade using the theme Keep Christ in Christmas. On Good Friday they did the Walk for Life followed by Stations of the Cross.

St. Ignatius Council work with the youth getting them involved in the Basketball Free Throw. They run the program Keep Christ in Christmas and Drug and Alcohol poster contest with great success.

They also make a monetary donation to the scholarship fund at the local school, Bay D' Espoir Academy.

St. Ignatius Council # 13763 also hire a summer student to help with the upkeep of the Parish lawns and any painting that's needs to be done around the church and the Parish Residence. St. Ignatius Council work the barbecue from 2:00p.m. to 3:00a.m. at the Local Cancer Benefit Fundraiser. In August they hold their Family Fun Day which includes music, games for kids, moon bounce, dunk tank, hot dogs and refreshments.
