2. Four main characters of this stage



A. Adam

- **(1) The first man by God's special creation (Gen. 1:1-2: 3)**
- **(2) A type of Christ (Rom. 5: 14)**
- **(3) The federal head of the human race (Rom. 5:14-19)**



B. Abel

- (1) Second son of Adam**
- (2) Pictures the righteous man, the regenerate believer, the man of faith.**
- (3) The first martyr and first true worshipper of God.**



C. Enoch

- (1) Man famously known for "walking with God" (Gen. 5:24)**
- (2) Pictures the believer's walk of faith, walking victoriously by the grace of God**
- (3) A pre-flood preacher.**



D. Noah

A man who followed in the footsteps of his great-grandfather, Enoch

- (1) Noah, too, was a pre-flood preacher.**
- (2) His life pictures the possibility of being used of God for great things because of great personal faith.**

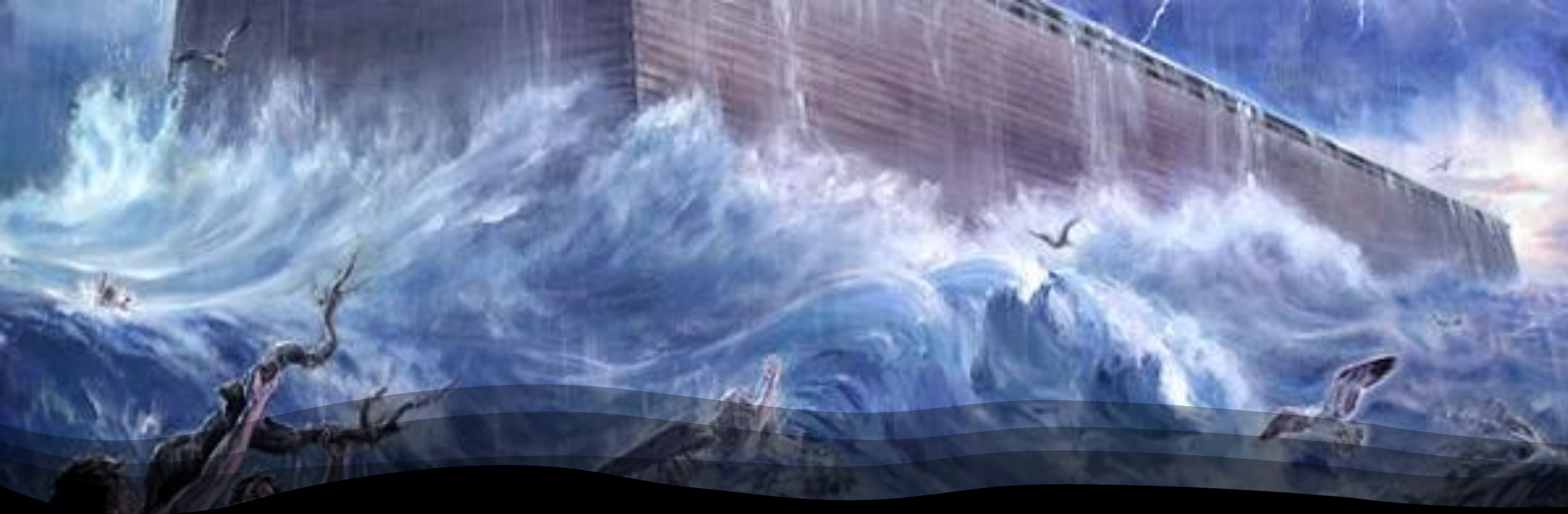

- 1) Sin enters the world with devastating consequences.
- 2) God's creation is savaged by the one element, He cannot condone -SIN.
- (3) God, mercifully promises a Savior (Gen. 3:15),



c. Flood (Gen. 6-9)

- (1) Sin reigns (corruption)
- (2) Judgment falls (justice)
- (3) One family survives (mercy)



d. Tower of Babel
(Gen. 10-11)

- d. Tower of Babel (Gen. 10-11)
 - (1) Rebel tower built by religious star-worshippers
 - (2) A picture of man's pride and arrogance (sin)
 - (3) Confusion of tongues (divine punishment)

2. Main characters of this period



a. Abraham (Gen.
11:26 -25:11)

- (1) First patriarch and father of Hebrew nation
- (2) Spiritual father of all Christians (Mt. 3:9; Rom. 11: 1)
- (3) An example of everyday, active faith in the living



b. Isaac (GENESIS 25:19-28:9; 36:1-43)

(1) The promised son born to Abraham and Sarah in their advanced age (Gen, 17:19,21; 23:3-12; 22:2-9)

(2) Isaac's supernatural birth illustrates the fulfillment of the prophesied Savior.

(3) Isaac, picture of a submissive son (Gen. 22:6,9)



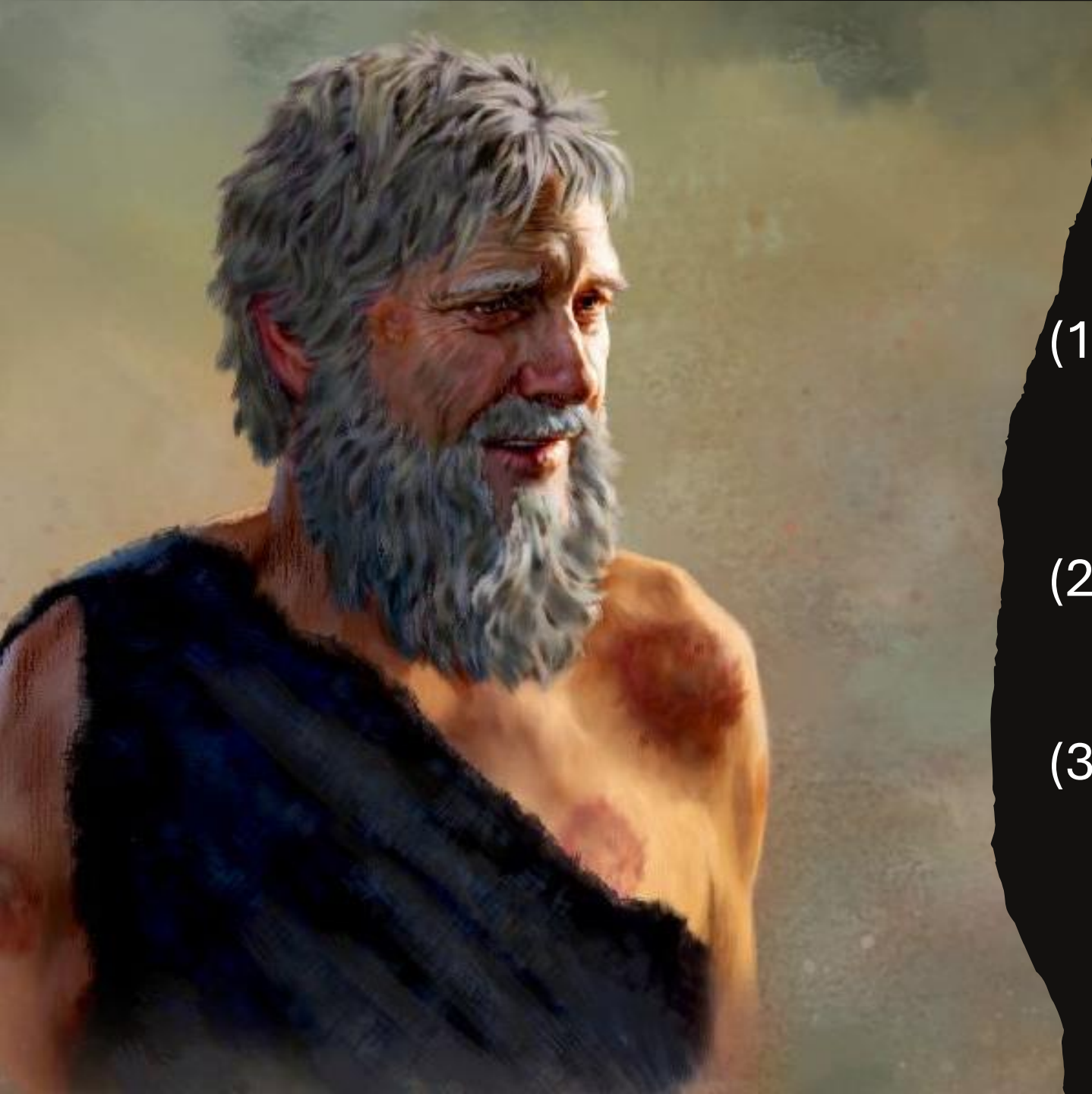
c. Jacob (GENESIS 28:10-35, 37-38)

- (1) Inheritor of the covenant (Gen. 25:23)
- (2) His life pictures the believer's struggle of two natures (Rom. 7).
- (3) Name changed to "Israel" which becomes the newname of God's covenant people (Gen. 22-31)



d. Joseph (GENESIS 37, 39-50)

- (1) Favored son of Jacob (Gen. 37:31)
- (2) A picture and example of a life of purity
- (3) The most inclusive and dramatic biblical type of Christ



e. Job

- (1) Old Testament patriarch - famous, not for his patience, but rather his perseverance (Jas. 5:11)
- (2) A picture of uprightness - steadfast faith in God no matter what the adversity
- (3) Years before the founding of the nation Israel, Job emphatically declares his faith in a Divine Redeemer (Job 19:25).

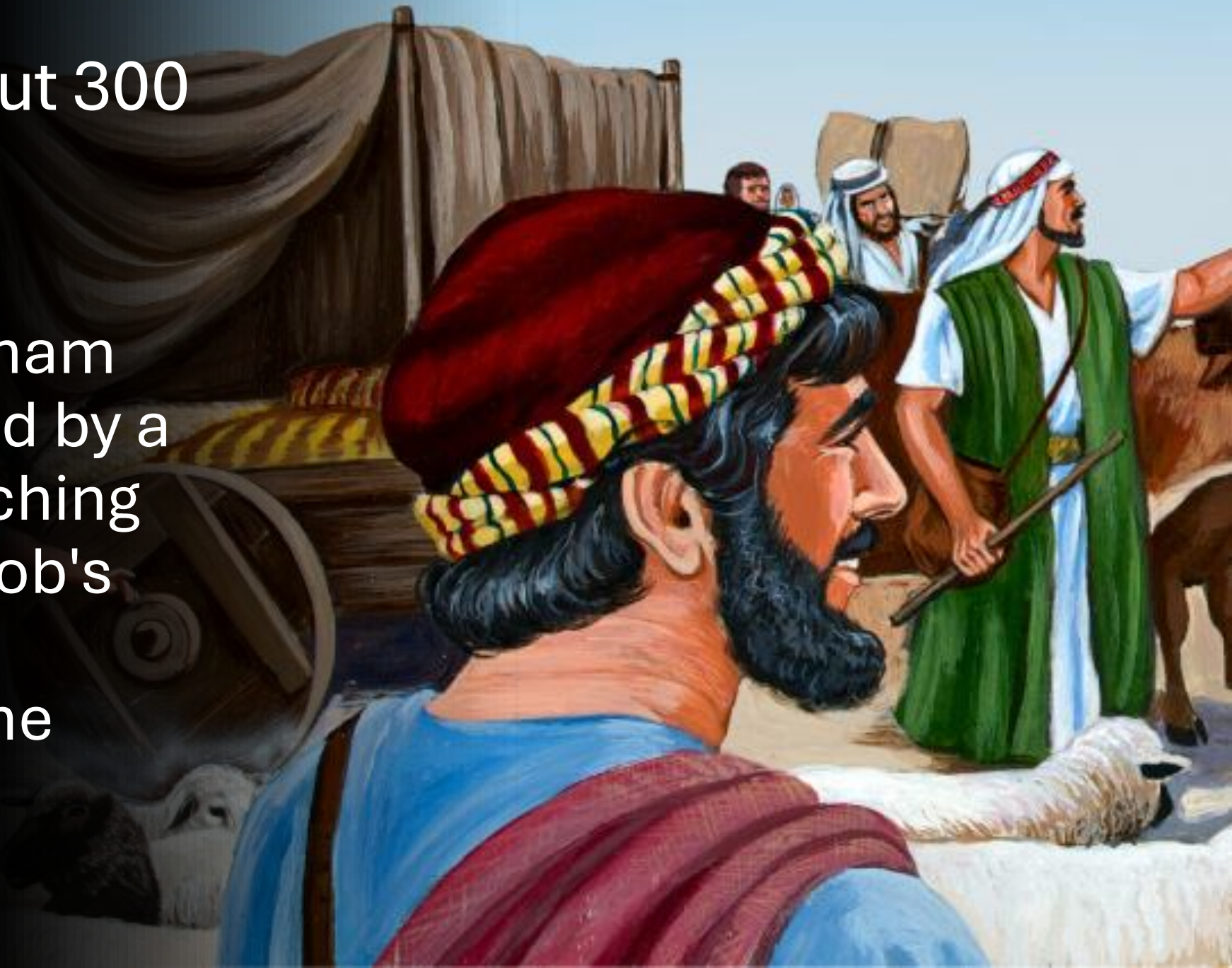

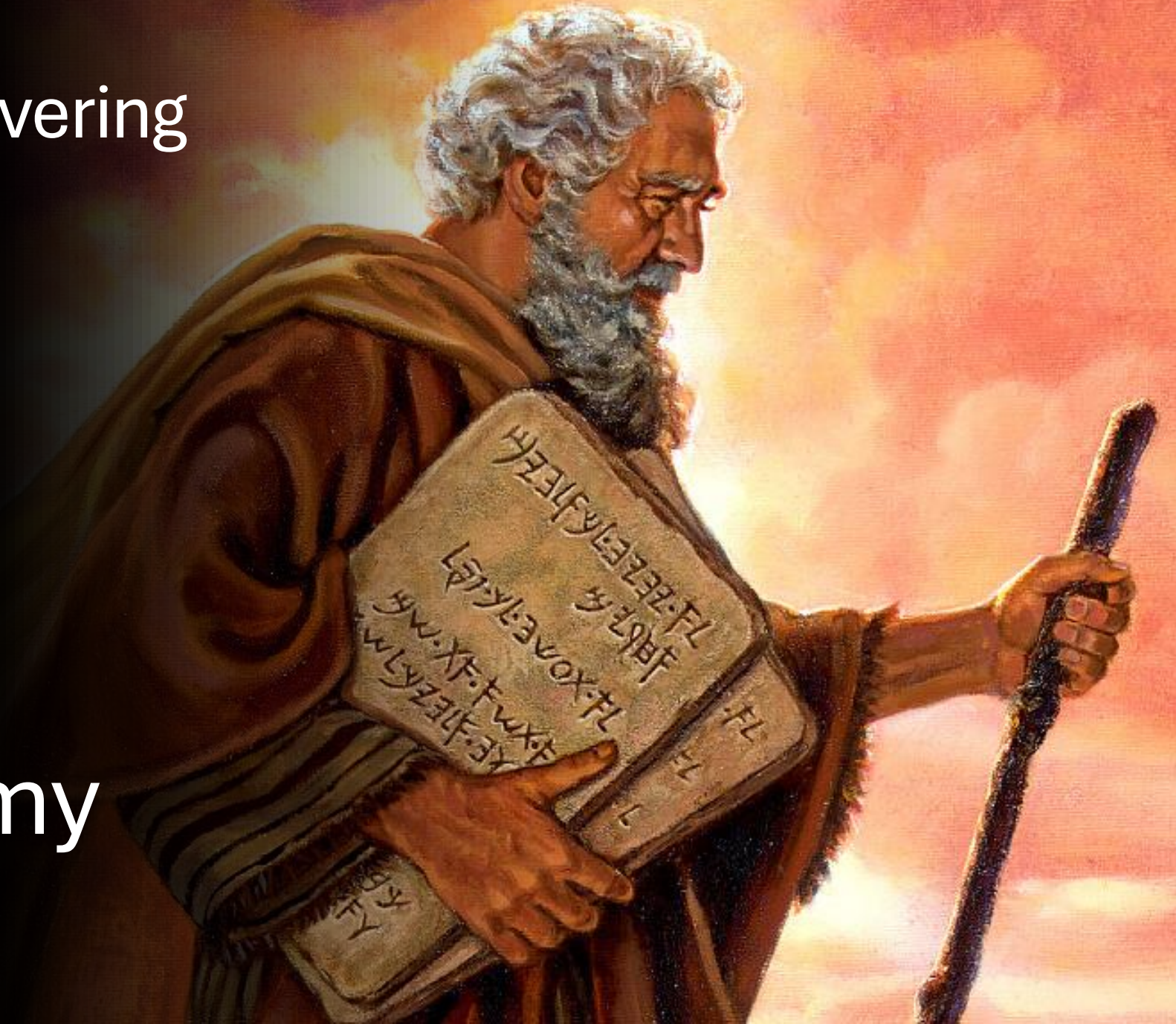
This occurs about 300 years from!

The birth of Abraham and is occasioned by a great famine reaching into Canaan. Jacob's household of 70 persons enters the land of Egypt.



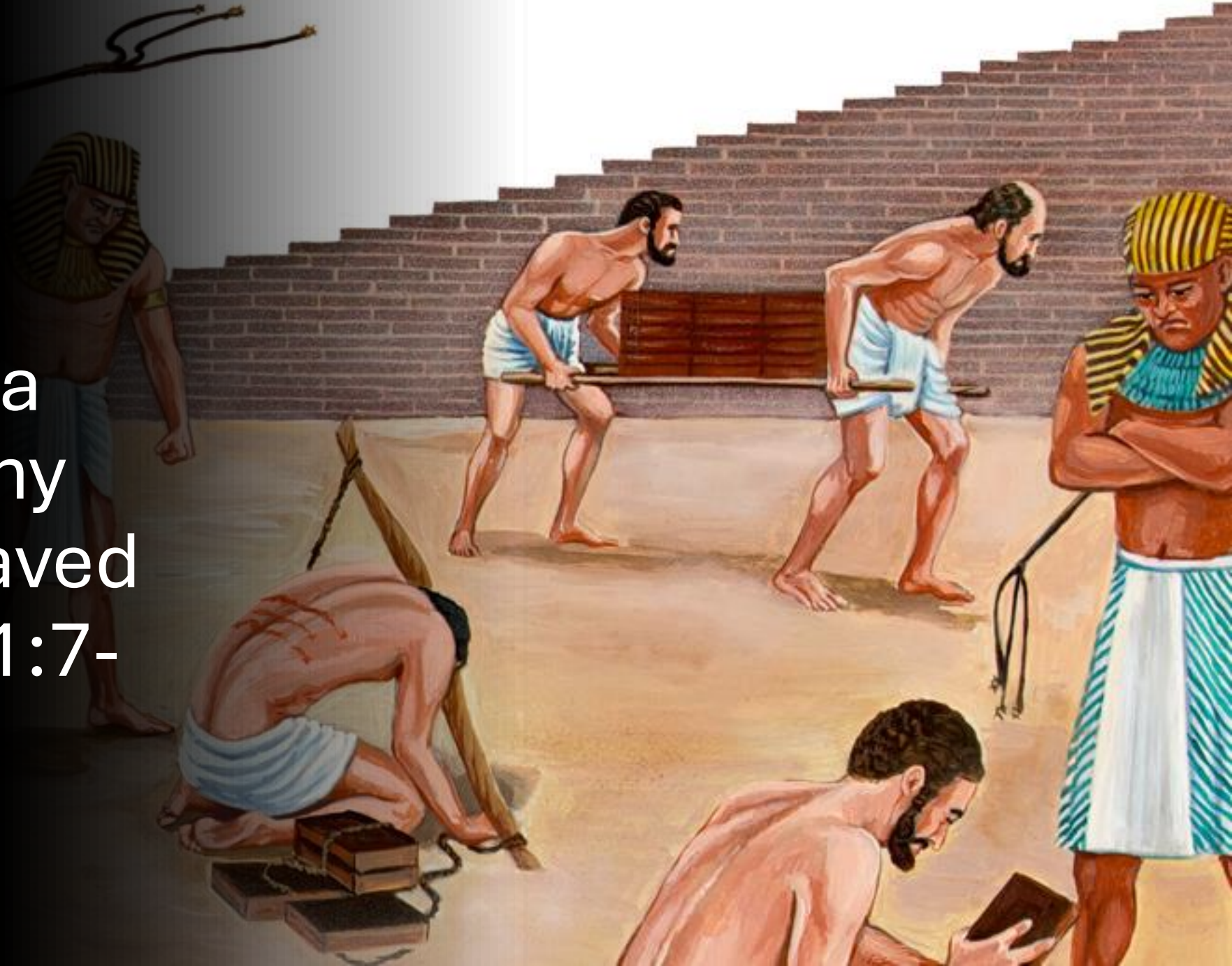

4. Fellowship

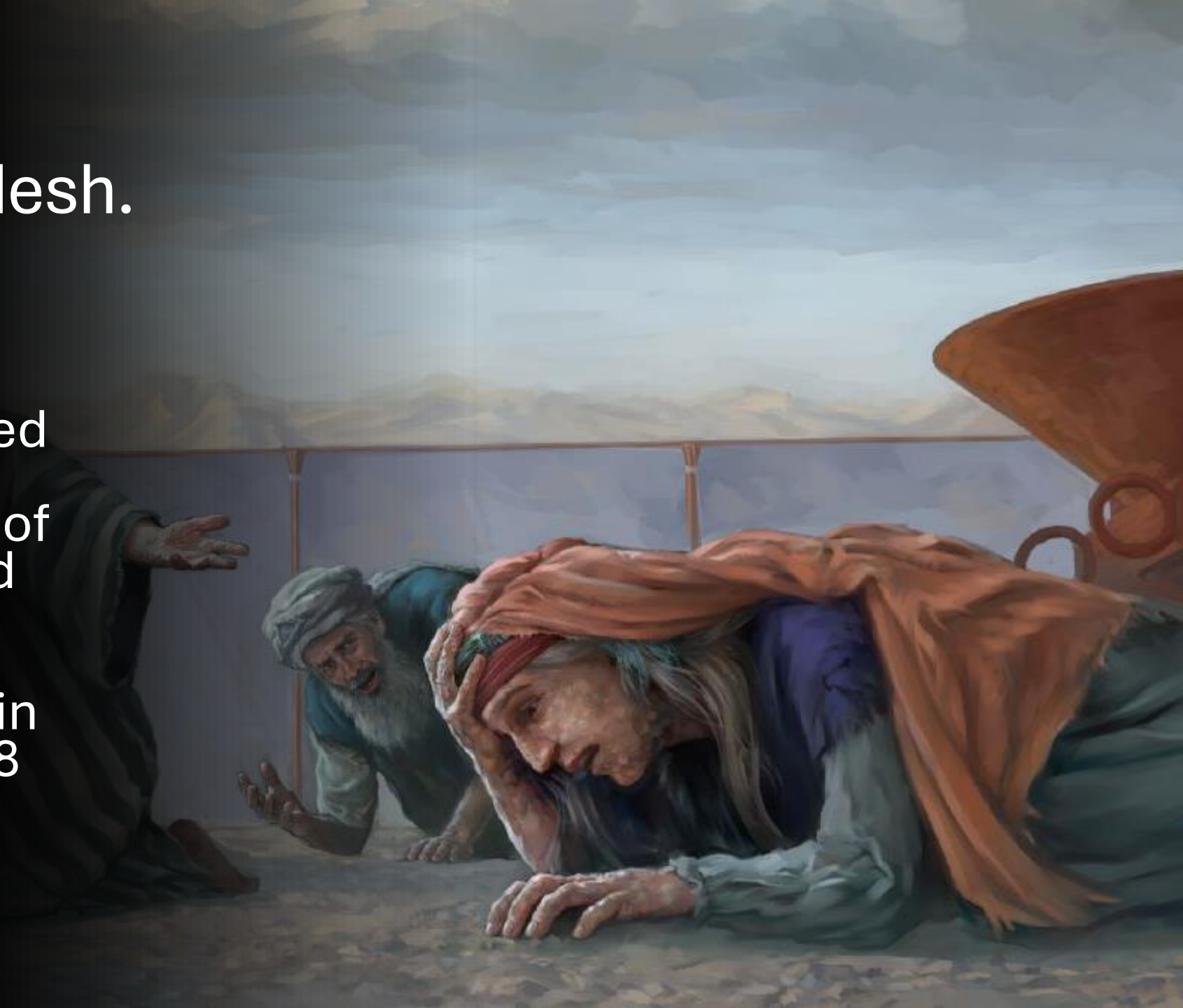
Three months after the Exodus, Israel camps at Sinai for nearly a year, and three major events occur:

- a. Giving of the Law - requirement for fellowship
- b. Corruption of golden calf incident -ruin of that fellowship
- c. Building of Tabernacle - restoration of that fellowship



5. Failure at Kadesh.

- On the occasion of entering the Promised Land, in spite of her glorious experience of redemption, law and fellowship, Israel chose to disbelieve and thus wandered in the wilderness for 38 years.
