Springs is here and DSW Authority are sponsoring House hold waste, electronic and paper shredding on June 6, 2015 from 8-2p.m. at UD Star Campus(old Chrysler Plant). YARD WASTE at Polly Drummond Rd is open from 8a.m. till sunset Wed.-Sun. Rt. 72 Site is open from 7:30 - 4 Mon. - Fri. and Sat., 7:30 till noon. Question was asked on the train situation. They have new regulations it will take 3 to 5 years to complete. Shipping crude oil is very dangerous with natural gas not being stable. Ed and 30 other colleges sent a letter to their Washington delegates to make the rails and material safer.
