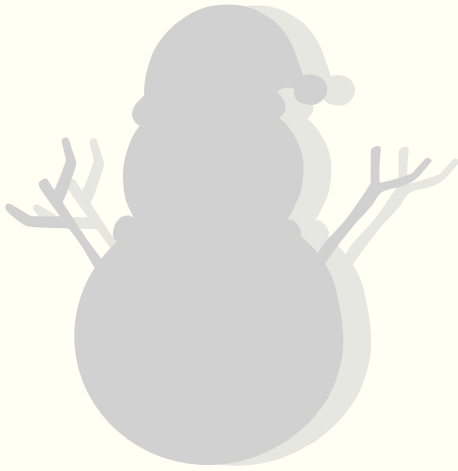

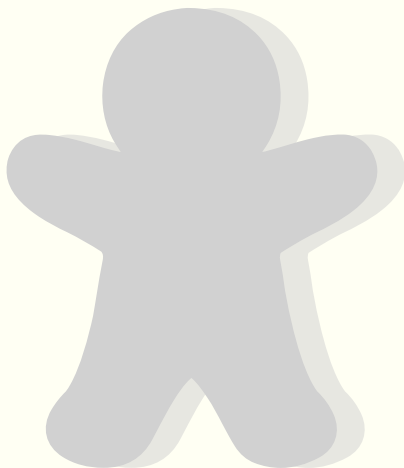


Sock Snowmen
