The Gakara Rare Earth Project located in the Bujumbura province of Burundi is a flagship project producing one of the world's highest-grade rare earth deposits in the north Easting Kibaran Fold Belt in the Burundi Supergroup. Mixed rare-earth carbonates consisting of neodymium and praseodymium elements used in electric vehicles and wind turbines are important as the globe transitions into sustainable energy sources.

The Belinga iron ore deposit, believed to be among the largest iron ore deposits in the world and with the country being the third largest producer of manganese making Gabon a critical component of the global steel industry

Zambia is renowned for its copper resources as they play a significant role in the global quest for clean energy. The GoviEx Uranium Muntanga uranium project in the Southern province of Zambia is noteworthy project consisting of large quantities of uranium which makes Zambia critical for the transition into clean renewable energy

Recent economical gold has been found in the Alibori region in Benin as small scale gold mine was done by artisanal miners in the Atakora Mountains.
