Lighting can dramatically affect the look and feel of each room in your home! When choosing the ideal bulb to pair with each fixture, it's important to remember that ambient, task and accent lighting are the 3 categories of light fixtures. For ambient lighting in cozy spaces, incandescent bulbs are the most traditional choice, known for their warm, glowing light. Compact fluorescent bulbs, or CFLs, are more energy efficient than incandescent. (These contain some mercury, so be careful when handling and disposing of them.) CFLs produce a cool, white light, with a wide range of colors and brightness. Popular for task or accent lighting, halogen bulbs emit a bright, white light similar to daylight. Halogen bulbs are less energy efficient than CFL or LED bulbs, but more energy efficient than incandescent. **LEDs** are an impressive energy-efficient option, as they tend to last years longer than all other bulbs. LEDs also come in a wide range of colors and brightness, and are cooler to the touch. Because LEDs are initially more expensive than other options, many cities and states with green initiatives offer rebates. With or without a rebate, LEDS end up being more economical, due to their longevity and potential savings on your electric bill. Boasting an average life expectancy of over 13+ years when used 10 hours a day, these are great for high ceiling applications, accents, or anywhere it's a challenge to replace a bulb!
