



What To Bring

Rafting, Kayak, Canoe, Wade & Off-Road Fishing

1. **Life Vest**, or one can be provided
2. **Fishing gear** or equipment can be provided
3. **Polarized Sunglasses**
4. **Water & snacks**
5. **Sunscreen**
6. **Hat**
7. **Bug Repellent**
8. **Sun-shirt & quick-dry pants**
9. **Hoodie, rain jacket & layers, dress for weather!**
10. **Shoes/sandals that can get wet**
11. **Waders if applicable to trip**

Requirements:

- 1- Sign all required liability waivers
- 2- Life Jacket always worn while on kayak, raft or canoe
- 3- MI Fishing license Required if you are over 17 yrs
- 4- Inform Fishing 4All Seasons of any health complications or physical limitations prior to trip.
- 5- Anyone under 18 years must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian

- Prior to your trip we'll conduct an in-person, phone or virtual meeting reviewing your fishing goals & customize your trip experience.
- Top of the line fishing equipment can be provided with notice, spinning or fly rods.
- Minn-Kota electric powered kayak is available on a guided kayak fishing trip, cover more water with a motorized kayak and experience hands-free kayak fishing.
- Drift a scenic river in a StealthCraft 3-person raft or large canoe equipped with stabilizers, hunt for trophy trout or smallmouth.
- Experience our Upper Peninsula's remote ORV Trails & back roads in a Jeep Wrangler, wade fish secluded river areas rarely visited by anglers.
- Bring a change of dry clothes for afterwards

Fishing locations are in Central Upper Michigan & Online Instruction via Google Meet.
