

The Summer Music Fest has it all when it comes to good music and good times! Polka/variety music is featured all ten days, in Polish, German, Austrian, Slovenian, and Dutch-Hop styles. Country Western Swing is back the during first weekend. Monday through Saturday are Rock 'N' Roll nights, when Bill Haley's Comets bolt into town Monday and Tuesday and the Hubcaps roll in Wednesday through Saturday. In this booklet are the stories about the various bands featured during the festival and the centerfold details when those bands are scheduled to perform during the ten days. The rest of the booklet features ads of interest, helping you decide where to eat and stay, and what to visit while in Frankenmuth, Michigan's #1 tourist attraction.

Many factors are involved in attracting people to a certain city and a particular festival. The Summer Music Fest features nearly 10,000 square feet of wooden dance floors, surrounded by ample seating at tables, all under two stadium-size tents. Throughout most of the week both these areas feature entertainment simultaneously—giving you a choice of music styles to enjoy. The food available ranges from full course meals of barbecued chicken, roast beef or pork chops, with a large assortment of side dishes, to finger foods such as brats, kielbasa, hot dogs and hamburgers. Beer, wine, wine coolers and soft drinks are always on hand to accompany any meal you choose. Festival favorites such as pretzels, popcorn and funnel cakes are also available in the concession tent.

The Summer Music Fest co-hosts, Marv and Teresa Herzog and Mark Janson, continue to put together the right factors to attract people from across the nation and around the world. They believe music is a common denominator in all people and the Summer Music Fest features music to get your friends together for a great time. 





Butch and Mary Kotowski, from Annapolis, Maryland, have been teaching people how to dance the polka since 1976. Their dancing talents have taken them to 150 exhibition dances around the country and their teaching abilities have enabled them to teach over 45,000 people how to polka dance. They have danced with the Lawrence Welk Travel Show in Maryland and on the cruise ship Fantasy and in the Bahamas. They have been the Summer Music Fest Dance Instructors since 1988, teaching classes in the afternoons, Monday through Friday. In 1991, their teaching was extended to include Saturday afternoon as well, meeting with such success that in 1992, free dance classes will be offered Monday through Saturday of the fest.

In addition to polka, they also teach Ballroom, Country Style, Figure Dances, Hustle and "Fun" dances. The classes will take place Monday - Friday, August 17 - 21, from 3:30 - 5:00 pm and on Saturday, August 22, from 1:30 - 5:00 pm. All are welcome to join. Meet people and become friends through the wonderful world of polka music.

Bill Haley's Comets

Just as Haley's Comet, that astronomical phenomenon, streaks across the skies on its 76-year run, so have Bill Haley's Comets, a group whose name is synonymous with rock'n'roll, returned. Their song, 'Rock-a-Beatin' Boogie' was the group's first hit and the phrase "Rock'N'Roll" was coined because of that song, forever symbolizing this ever-popular style of music.

Led by singer Joey Rand, the only original Comet who is still in the group, the Comets have carried the torch of this special rock'n'roll since Haley died in 1981. The only group authorized to carry the Haley name, the Comets, best known for the hits 'Rock Around the Clock' and 'Shake, Rattle, and Roll', will appear at the Summer Music Fest on Monday and Tuesday, August 17 and 18. The evening begins at 7:30 pm with a show, followed by dancing until 11:30 pm.



Bavarian Pretzels and Popcorn have always gone hand in hand with festivals. Made fresh every day in Heritage Park, pretzels and popcorn are that perfect snack when you're not really hungry but want to munch on something.

When attending the Summer Music Fest in Frankenmuth this year, try a hot pretzel with a little dab of mustard or enjoy a box of buttered popcorn and taste for yourself why these two favorites are synonymous with a festival.



SUMMER MUSIC NOTE

Cold drinks are a festival favorite to go with any food & snacks. Pop, beer, wine and coolers are available in an array of flavors. No "carry-ins" of food or beverages allowed.

Finger Foods are any foods consumed without the aid of a fork, knife or spoon — quick foods to eat between dance sets. Under this category are pizza, sloppy joes, hamburgers, cheeseburgers, hot dogs and bratwurst and kielbasa (with or without kraut). When you don't want to miss the action, grab a finger food and keep on going at the Summer Music Fest.

Bavarian Funnel Cakes have been a festival mainstay since the beginning.
