What makes a festival memorable? Good music, good food, good atmosphere and good friends. The Summer Music Fest has it all when it comes to good music and good times. In the world of Polish Polka music, the big ones are coming to Frankenmuth: Eddie Blazonczyk, Polka Family, Lenny Gomulka and Henny & the Versa J's, all joining Mark Janson and the Brass Express. 
POLKA-LESSONS
