Summer Music Fest has become more than "Just another festival". It has become the "Party of the Year"! What makes a good party? Music, Food, Drinks, and People. And the Summer Music Fest has it all, a harmonious blend of different styles of music that attracts a wide variety of music lovers, from polka to big band to rock 'n' roll.

In the world of Polish Polka music, the big ones are coming to Frankenmuth: Eddie Blazonczyk, Polka Family, Lenny Comulka and Dick Pillar, all joining Mark Janson and the Brass Express. In addition to Polish, the Summer Music Fest

offers the Austrian sound of Walt Groller, the button-box music of The Polish Kid, Don Cialkoszewski, the Slovenian sound of Verne and Steve Meisner, Joe Fedorchak and Bob Turcola, the Dulcimer music of the Polka Nuts, country Western Swing with Dave Dighton, and the entertaining style of The Concord Singers, all joining Marv Herzog & the Bavarian Polka Band. The Hubcaps roll into town with their special style of Rock 'n' Roll Wednesday thru Saturday. The Summer Music Fest

is bringing back the Big Band sound again in 1994 with "Music in the Morgan Manner", the Russ Morgan Orchestra with Jack Morgan conducting, alternating with the Satin Brass Orchestra with John Lipinski conducting, on Thursday night, August 18.

In this booklet are stories about these various bands featured during the festival and the centerfold details when those bands are scheduled to perform during the ten days. The rest of the booklet features ads of interest, helping you decide where to eat and stay and what to visit while in Frankenmuth - Michigan's #1 tourist attraction.

> Many factors are involved in attracting people to a certain city and a particular festival. The Summer Music Fest features almost 10,000

square feet of wooden dance floors, surrounded by ample seating at tables, all under 80,000 square feet of tented area. The food available range from full course meals of barbecued chicken, roast beef or pork chops with a large assortment of side dishes to finger foods such as brats, kielbasa, hot dogs, and hamburgers. Beer, wine coolers, wine, bottled water and soft drinks are always on hand to accompany any meal you choose. Festival favorites such as pretzels, popcorn and funnel cakes are also available in the Concession Tent.

The Summer Music Fest cohosts, Marv and Teresa Herzog and Mark Janson, continue to put together the right factors to attract people from across the nation and around the world. So come to Frankenmuth August 12-21, be part of the excitement of the "Party of the Year".









#### Lenny Gomulka & Chicago Push

Lenny Gomulka was born in Chicago, Illinois, and formed his own band in 1980, after being a member of Eddie Blazonczyk's Versatones. Lenny has led his band throughout the country appearing in nearly every major festival coast to coast. He has been named *Male Vocalist of the Year* many times and is the youngest inductee into the International Polka Music Hall of Fame. He has been nominated for a Grammy four times, the most recent in 1993.

Lenny now lives in Indian Orchard, Massachusetts, and his band brings together some of the top musicians in the polka world. Lenny is as excellent as ever on trumpet, sax and clarinet. Other members of the band are: Ted Borzymowski - accordion and concertina; Mike Evan - trumpet; John Mikos - concertina; Brian Chenkus - bass; and Dave Raccis - drums as well as impersonations of polka personalities. All the members share the vocals.
