5-gallon mixing bucket

DIRECTIONS

1. Fill the jug/bucket with water to the water line.
2. Based on the **lowest expected daily outside temperature**, pour in the appropriate amount of window wash solution to reach the corresponding solution guideline.
3. Fill the remainder of the jug/bucket up with water until level reaches about 1.5 inches from the top of the container.
It will be helpful to make a mark on your jug at the 1.5-inch mark so you have consistent and easy filling.

COLD WEATHER GUIDELINES

- Only mix 1-2 quarts of usable solution per bucket at one time.
- Change solution as often as necessary.
- Solution should be changed a minimum of every 24 hours.

As customers use window wash, ice/snow from windows can mix in the windshield wash solvent, causing dilution. Dilution will cause the product to slush. Snow & inclement weather can also add water to the mixture.

If your Window Wash was mixed for 32° or above and the temperature drops below freezing during extreme temperature fluctuations (i.e. beginning and end of seasons), dispose of mix in bucket on the island before adding new mix.

Trying to add stronger solution to already mixed Window Wash will result in product freezing or crystalizing!
For best results, mix Window wash for the lowest temperature of the day, not the high.

**1-Gallon Mixing Jug
Recommended Dilutions**

Night Time Low Temperature (°F)	Oz/Gal
Above 32°	2oz/1 gallon of water
18°-32°	6oz/1 gallon of water
5°-18°	18oz/1 gallon of water
Below 5°	Up to 64oz/1 gallon of water

**5-Gallon Mixing Bucket
Recommended Dilutions**

Night Time Low Temperature (°F)	Oz/Gal
Above 32°	8oz/4 gallon of water
18°-32°	24oz/4 gallon of water
5°-18°	72oz/4 gallon of water
Below 5°	256oz/4 gallon of water
