Encore Performance Team

TBPAA's Encore Performance Troupe is accepting Applications for the 2019/2020 Year May 10-June 10. This team requires commitment and focus, and will require practice at home as well as in studio. Admission to the team will be by audition or director permission. It is open to ages 8-18.

This group is a Performance Troupe and does not compete. Instead, this group brings their talent to events in Florida. The group is taught to be professional performers and will need to adhere to rules, regulations, and requirements of different performance venues.

There will be three team levels -- Juniors, Seniors and Elite. All levels will perform together in a variety of shows and in The Palm Harbor Holiday Parade, and if the team is selected at Disney Springs, Florida State Fair, Florida Strawberry Festival, Gullaire Village, and/or Chasco Fiesta. The groups may perform separately at other venues. All levels require an audition.

The **Juniors** will have a one-hour weekly rehearsal and will be expected to rehearse at home. They will be responsible for learning lyrics and choreography for a minimum of 4 song/dance numbers during the year plus a Holiday Parade sequence. All members will sing and dance in most numbers. Two Lead Singers will be chosen for solo or duet parts in some songs in the group's full show performances and the TBPAA Showcases. All ages can apply for the Junior Team.

The **Seniors** will have a one-hour weekly rehearsal and will participate in the same activities outlined above for Juniors except perform at Senior Level skills but will learn and perform a minimum of 6 song/dance numbers during the year plus a Holiday Parade sequence. To be eligible for the Senior level, a team member must be: at least 10-yrs-old and have at least one year of Encore Experience or permission of the Director to audition for this level. (participation on other performance and/or competition teams can be substituted for the one- year of Encore Experience).

Criteria considered in choosing the Senior team includes but is not limited to:

- Regular Attendance at rehearsals in previous years
- Level of commitment demonstrated at team events and practices (such as: coming to rehearsals prepared and on time, knowing the choreography and lyrics taught the week before)
- Ability to handle costume changes and costume care without assistance
- Demonstrated ability to following multi-part performance directions
- Performance of Senior Level Skill Set

The **Elite Level** will have a one-hour weekly rehearsal and will participate in all Intermediate & Advance Level activities outlined above. In addition, they will have some additional rehearsals and commitments. To be eligible for the Elite Level, a team member must by at least 11-yrs-old and have at least two years of Encore Experience or permission of the Director and have met all the criteria of Senior Level to apply.

Criteria considered in choosing the Elite Team includes all criteria in the Senior Level plus:

- Ability to follow multipart performance directions without additional clarifications
- Demonstrate maturity in behavior in various settings
- Demonstrate performing professionalism both inside and outside of Tampa Bay Performing Arts Academy
- Be professional when interacting with TBPAA directors or venue staff
- Have the ability to adjust to changes of directions or choreography on the fly during performance events
- Performance of Elite Level Skill Set

The Elite Level will require members to attend pre-scheduled extra rehearsals and to come to class prepared to rehearse.

Students at this level must be able to rehearse for a full hour with very little breaks.

Prior to requesting an audition or accepting an invitation to join the team — please review the materials in this packet and be sure that both you and your student **are willing and able to make the commitments required**.

If your student is involved with other activities, please check all dates for conflicts.

Mandatory Performance Dates: Disney Springs, Palm Harbor Holiday Parade and at least 2 TBPAA Showcases.

Students are allowed to miss up to 3 regular rehearsals. If a student misses a mandatory long rehearsal before a major performance, they may not be allowed to participate in that event. If a student misses more than 3 rehearsals without prior permission, they may be dismissed from the team and all monies paid will be forfeited.

Once your application has been reviewed, you will receive an audition time. The audition for the team will consist of learning a song and dance sequence as a group. Those wishing to audition for Lead Singer should prepare 1 song or piece of a song 2-minutes or less that demonstrates their vocal ability. National Anthem singers will be asked to sing the Anthem a cappella.

The director's will place each team member in the appropriate level for them to be challenged and to perform their best after auditions, but the below guidelines are moves that may be included in the different audition levels.
