Standing for election as an independent can be a lonely task. Many Parities have Party Members who deliver leaflets, knock on doors, raise funds and campaign for their candidates. Independents generally have none of these resources, but often join together with other Independents to a local cause.

The Independent Network has been helping Independents get elected since 2005. Research by the electoral commission shows that voters have less trust of candidates with no logo. Voters use the logo to find the candidate they want to support. In April 2016, the Independent Network was registered with the electoral commission as a party in order to be transparent and better support candidates in England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.


