Beta Sigma Chapter is the largest and oldest graduate chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. in the Montgomery area. Building upon the legacy and vision of the seven Founders, the chapter supports the pursuit of higher education by offering scholarships to undergraduate students and sorors.

The Beta Sigma Academic Excellence scholarship assists students with obtaining a bachelor's degree from a four-year college/university. A Beta Sigma Academic Excellence Scholar will typically demonstrate the following: academic talent (20%); excellent writing skills and a desire to pursue a professional career (40%); and strong leadership ability through a balance of honors and awards (10%), extracurricular activities and community service (20%) and recommendations (10%).

Applications are for:

- An undergraduate who currently attends a 4-year college/university **OR** an undergraduate member of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. and a member of Beta Chi chapter (ASU) or Pi Lambda Chapter (AUM).
- Current resident of the Montgomery Metropolitan area
- Student who possesses a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (unweighted)

Application Deadline:

Applications must be received **via email by February 3, 2026**. Confirmation of receipt will be sent via email only. Incomplete applications and those received after **February 3, 2026** will not be considered.

Notification to Applicants and Scholarship Recipients....

Applicants who are selected to receive a scholarship will be notified via email. Upon notification, recipients are required to send their acceptance of the scholarship, provide a headshot photograph for publication and confirm their participation in an awards recognition ceremony or event.

Applicants who are not selected will be notified by email only. The scholarship is not renewable

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Read the application carefully and complete all sections

- ✓ A current undergraduate in the Montgomery, AL Metropolitan Area with the intent of obtaining a four-year degree.
- ✓ Minimum of a 3.0 cumulative GPA (submit a **SEALED COPY OFFICIAL COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT**).
 - Include an official transcript, which includes current term/semester of courses taken.
- ✓ **Minimum** of 60 service hours within school and/or community (documentation required).
- ✓ 3 letters of recommendation - **2 academic references** (teacher, counselor, administrator etc.) and **1 personal reference** (cannot be a family member).

Be sure to select writers of your recommendation who know you well and can speak knowledgeably and passionately about your overall character, including length of time they have known you, examples of your work ethic, leadership ability, and commitment to your goals.

-instruct each writer to enclose their letter in a sealed envelope and to affix their name across the seal. Letters must be mailed with your application.
- ✓ Submit a typed 2-3 page, double spaced, 12-point font essay on one of the following topics:
 - 1. Describe your most meaningful achievements and how they relate to your field of study and your future goals.**
 - 2. Pick an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced your development.**
 - 3. Who in your life has been your biggest influence and why?**
- ✓ Spring 25 schedule and Proof of Enrollment from the registrar's office will be required to receive scholarship funds.
