Definition


Nausea is a feeling of sickness and uneasiness of the stomach with an inclination to vomit (Psora).

Vomiting (Psora) is the forcible voluntary or involuntary emptying of stomach.

Pathophysiology

The organs involved in act of nausea and vomiting are-

- gastrointestinal tract- stasis or irritation of the mucosa (Psora)
- Chemoreceptor Trigger Zone (CTZ) in the base of the fourth ventricle
- vestibular apparatus and
- cerebral cortex



These areas stimulate the vomiting center in the brainstem via primary neurotransmitters-dopamine, serotonin, acetylcholine, and histamine (Psora).

Vomiting center coordinates the act of vomiting via autonomic efferents to the upper gastrointestinal tract, diaphragm and abdominal muscles.

Causes

Causes of nausea and vomiting can be categorized as under-

A. Mediated by effects on the gastrointestinal tract

Gastro-intestinal transit time increases in advanced cancer. Delayed gastric emptying is main responsible cause.

- i. Gastric outflow obstruction
 - o obstruction (partial or complete) (Causa occasionalis/ Cancerous/ Syphilis/ Sycosis)
 - o mass effect (hepatic or other tumor mass, carcinomatosis) (Causa occasionalis/ Cancerous/ Syphilis/ Sycosis)
 - o constipation (Psora)
- ii. Gastric mucosal inflammation (NSAID's, steroids, antibiotics, blood, ethanol, stress) (Causa occasionalis)
- iii. Gastric stasis (Psora/ Syphilis)
- iv. Vagal stimulation (Causa occasionalis/ Psora)
- v. Oesophageal causes
 - o extrinsic or intrinsic compression (Causa occasionalis)
 - o mucosal inflammation due to reflux or infections such as candidiasis or herpes simplex (Psora/ Sycosis/ Pseudopsora)

B. Mediated by chemical mechanism (usually via CTZ)

- i. Drugs (Causa occasionalis)
 - o opioids
 - o antibiotics and anticonvulsants
 - o chemotherapy and radiotherapy
- ii. Biochemical

- Hypercalcaemia (Psora/ Sycosis)
- Uraemia (Syphilis/ Sycosis)
- liver failure (Syphilis)
- Toxins (tumor factors, infection) (Psora)

C. CNS

Raised intracranial pressure e.g. brain metastases, leptomeningeal disease, bleeding.
(Causa occasionalis)

D. Vestibular

Motion sickness. (Psora)

Cerebellar tumour. (Cancerous/ Sycosis)

E. Unexplained nausea and vomiting

Sometimes, no cause is traceable. (Psora/ Causa occasionalis)

Management

Goals of Management

- To Identify and treat reversible causes whenever possible
- Stop or significantly reduce the vomiting
- Re-hydrate the patient
- Abolish nausea
- Restore appetite and oral intake

Homoeopathic treatment

FEMALE - MENSES - painful, dysmenorrhea - nausea and vomiting, with *kreos.* *sars.* *verat-v.*

FEMALE GENITALIA/SEX - FETUS - motions - nausea and vomiting from the motions *arn.*

FEMALE GENITALIA/SEX - MENSES - painful - nausea and vomiting *Verat.*

FEMALE SEXUAL SYSTEM - Uterus - Haemorrhage - With - blood - clotted or fluid; paroxysmal or continual flow; nausea, vomiting - palpitation, pulse quick, feeble when moved; vital depression; fainting on raising head from pillow *apoc.*

FEVER, HEAT - GASTRIC fever - nausea, vomiting, dry, baked looking tongue, rapid pulse, abdominal tenderness and diarrhea, with *bapt.*

Foetus - movement - causes nausea and vomiting *arn.*

GENERALITIES - COLDNESS - nausea, vomiting, with *valer.*

HEAD - CONGESTION, hyperemia etc. - general - nausea and vomiting, with *VERAT-V.*

HEAD - PAIN - Sides - left - lying - agg. - redness and bloated swelling of the cheek with nausea and vomiting; with *apis*

HEAD - PULSATING - night - appears in the night, with nausea and vomiting *sil.*

HEAD - PULSATING, beating, throbbing - night - nausea and vomiting, with *sil.*

MALE SEXUAL SYSTEM - Coitus - Followed by - Nausea, vomiting *mosch.*

Migraine - nausea, vomiting, with *ip.*

MOUTH - CLEAN, clear tongue - nausea and vomiting, during *IP.*






