Critical chronic cases with gross pathology Start with Acute Remedies



- Mechanism of Hepatic cyst rupture
 - Old age
 - Immunocompromised patient
 - Latent Psora
 - Sulphur re-activated Psora
 - Inflammatory processes started
 - Cystic lysis took place
 - ICU engaged

- Second prescription with cure
 - Acute inflammatory stage
 - Aconite
 - Acute of Sulphur
 - Much improvement
 - Sulphur
 - Case cured

Hypersensitive and autoimmune cases Start with Remedies similar to mental symptoms

- Mechanism of pyoderma development-
 - Childhood age
 - Hypersensitive, autoimmune patient
 - Active Psora
 - Lycopodium, the similimum remedy caused aggravation of all the ailments
 - Severe inflammatory processes started
 - Opportunistic infections took place and pyoderma started
 - PICU engaged

- Second prescription with cure
 - Acute inflammatory and supportive stage
 - Mentals prevailing- aversion playing and petulance (moodiness)
 - Rheum
 - Much improvement
 - Lycopodium
 - Case cured



Failure -3 Seizure disorder- Increased ICT with Silicea


Learning from Failure

Hypersensitive and hormonal compromised cases Start with Remedies based on causative symptoms

- Mechanism of increased intra cranial tension-
 - Hypersensitive hormonal compromised patient with suppressed menses
 - Active Psora
 - Silicea, the similimum remedy caused aggravation of all the ailments
 - Cerebral hyperemia started
 - Intracranial hypertension developed
 - ICU engaged

- Second prescription with cure
 - Severe ICT
 - Causation prevailing- menses absent for a long time in a hysteric women
 - Cypripedium pubescense
 - Much improvement
 - Case cured

Failure -4 Spondylolisthesis-Totally failed without physiotherapy



Learning from Failure

Disorders with bio-mechanical changes Start with Physical/ Surgical measures along with indicated remedy

- Mechanism of failure in spondylolisthesis-
 - Mechanical disorder
 - Dislocation of vertebra
 - Guaiccum, Kali iod, Bryonia alba, Colocynth, Pulsatilla, Tellureum, Lachesis, the best indicated remedies at various times did not relieve, rather caused aggravation of all the ailments
 - Patient became bed ridden
 - Private ward engaged

- Second prescription with cure
 - Dislocation of a vertebra over another
 - Causation for pain and radiculopathy prevailing
 - Physiotherapy
 - MIND CENSORIOUS everything; desire to criticize:
 Guaiccum
 - Much improvement
 - Case cured
