Trivia Answer: By Andrea Hardy and Erica Colleton

Question: It's Spring and your ball is in a fairway in a puddle of water (temporary water) — what are your options?

Answer: Your ball is in what the Rules call "temporary water." You may play your ball as it lies or take free relief. You take free relief by finding the nearest point of complete relief where you are clear of the puddle and then drop your original ball or another ball away from the puddle and within one club-length of that point not nearer the hole. You may also take relief from a puddle of water if your ball is in a bunker or on the putting green, but you do not get relief from a puddle inside a penalty area.
