Allie played exceptionally well in this tournament, and she continues to work on perfecting her skills to meet the goals set for herself.



TWIG KIDZ Justine Pennycooke and Tyler Spriggs have been "golf buddies" since the tender age of 6, bonding during Donna Learner Golf Academy practice sessions and supporting each other during Drive, Chip, and Putt competitions and U.S. Kids Golf Association tournaments. In their teens, Justine and Tyler refined their golf games and became leaderboard contenders (and winners) during regional/national competitive tournaments – including Peggy Kirk Bell Girls Golf and Carolina Golf Association tourneys – and are among the best junior girls' golfers in North Carolina. Justine joined TWIG KIDZ in 2018, and Tyler has been a member since 2016.

Now, as Green Hope High School (GHHS) seniors and TWIG KIDZ advanced players, Justine and Tyler are turning the page on high school golf, reflecting on their TWIG Kidz experience, and imagining the next chapter in their lives.

Since freshman year, Justine and Tyler have helped lead the Cary-based GHHS Girls Varsity Golf Team to impressive NCHSAA Triangle-8 Conference championships and regional and state recognition. As co-captains this year, they placed among the top 10 girls' golfers during regional and state championships and earned First-Team All-Conference nods all four years. Justine was selected SWAC Conference champion, player of the year, and GHHS team MVP. Tyler took top honors in the SAS Junior Open at Prestonwood and is the 2022 First Tee of the Triangle Junior Volunteer of the Year.

"We really appreciate every opportunity the TWIG ladies have provided us and their genuine interest in our goals," says Justine. Tyler adds, "TWIG's influence goes beyond golf. We've benefited from their support both on- and off-the-course and appreciate their active involvement in our success." Both girls' mentor younger TWIG golfers, are involved in community activities, and play during the TWIG Foundation Annual Invitational Golf Tournament and the Doug Boyd Foundation Tournament fundraisers.

Justine and Tyler also excel off-the-course, maintaining honor roll status throughout high school. Justine cofounded GHHS's Falcon Frenzy club that helps boost school spirit at sporting events. Tyler co-founded the GHHS Black Student Association that gives students a voice on campus.

What's next for these two exceptional young ladies who stay true to their authentic selves? College, of course, with Justine pursuing sports marketing and management, and Tyler focused on biomedical cancer research.
