Scholarship Requirements and Application

In recognition of the 25th anniversary of TWIG Kidz, a program of the Triangle Women in Golf (TWIG) Foundation, Inc. which introduces young women (ages 6-18) to golf with the intention of inspiring them to continue playing the game, the TWIG Foundation may award up to three (3) scholarships in 2026 in honor of Shirley A. Cook based on:

- Scholastic achievement
- Performances on a written essay and personal virtual interview
- Level of community involvement
- Recommendation

The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the TWIG Foundation Board. Selection of the scholarship recipients will be made by the TWIG Foundation Selection Committee, and approval will be made by the Executive Board.

Scholarship requirements:

- ☐ Candidate must be
 - Currently enrolled or accepted in an accredited college or university, including a community college
 - Adult learner or nontraditional student, currently enrolled or accepted in an accredited college or university, including a community college
 - Currently enrolled or accepted in an accredited college or university, including a community college for a Graduate, Professional or Vocational or Technical degree
- ☐ A minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent and in good academic standing

Preferred but not required:

- ☐ Participation in TWIG Kidz Program or other golf related program
- ☐ Female candidate

Student application procedures:

Each candidate will submit:

- Completed scholarship application form
- One (1) letter of recommendation (Nonfamily member)
- Unofficial transcript and acceptance letter
- Written essay
 - The essay should be 1-2 pages typed and double spaced
 - Please address the following topic in your essay: Golf is an individual sport. How do you think playing golf will or can make you a better individual socially, mentally or physically?
 - Also include in the essay a presentation of your ideas on what you can do as an individual to improve your community and a statement regarding your future goals.
- Additional items to support the application may include documented evidence of awards, honors, certificates, involvement in the community, etc.

Deadline for submitting scholarship applications is August 15, 2026.
