I am pleased to issue the official convention call for the 51st International Convention of the Coalition of Black Trade Unionists (CBTU). The convention will be held in Los Angeles, CA at the Westin Bonaventure Hotel & Suites, 404 Figueroa St., Los Angeles, CA 90071 from May 25-30, 2022. The theme is "Power of the Past - Force of the Future". All general convention sessions will be held at the Westin Bonaventure.

This will be our first in-person convention in 2 years. COVID-19 has ravaged our communities and attacks on our democracy - built on The BIG LIE - threaten the rights of millions of voters of color. Yet, in the face of this adversity, workers are rising up, demanding higher wages and a bigger voice in the workplace decisions. They are challenging a corrupt system that shields the wealth of the rich while saddling working people and students with crushing debt. We need to gather safely to assess this moment and CBTU's role in 2022 and beyond. We also need to tap into the energy, inspiration, and "sense of oneness" that can only be experienced when the CBTU family is together under the same roof. Virtual hugs can only do so much!
