Entering Sophomore year essay subject: "Leadership and Services, What Does it Mean?"
Entering Junior year essay subject: "Valuing Our Vote"
Entering Senior year essay subject: "A College Education, Provides Me Choices "
Qualified Trades Applicants may pick from one of the following subjects: "Why Should Young People Who Don't Attend College Learn a Trade." or "Why Should Young People in Labor be Civically Engaged?"
Essays will be judged on content, grammar, sentence structure and punctuation. (Please note, "I", "to", "a" will not be
considered words for the purpose of the word count of 300.)
